I-PASS Users: Got Violations? You Can Fix Them. Learn How.

You may have received a toll violation notice if:

- Your license plate is not registered to your I-PASS account
- Your specialty license plate type is not indicated on your I-PASS account
- The credit card registered to your account has expired
- Your transponder was not in the car or was improperly mounted

If your I-PASS account was in good standing at the time of the violation, a customer service representative may be able to dismiss the \$20 fine and charge your account only the cash toll rate.

If your account was not in good standing, you are responsible for the fines and tolls.

Use your I-PASS to Drive on the Ohio Turnpike



Ohio Turnpike toll plazas began accepting toll payments using E-ZPass on October 1. Larger toll plazas have dedicated lanes available exclusively for electronic toll payment, so you can use your I-PASS, i-Zoom, or E-ZPass. As driver participation increases, smaller toll plazas with lower volumes of traffic will open

dedicated electronic payment lanes.

Customers using I-PASS will receive the Ohio E-ZPass toll rate. Customers paying cash will see a 40 percent increase in tolls.

Did You Know...

The Tollway is installing a Weigh-In-Motion (WIM) station to capture commercial vehicles weight in real-time at normal travel speeds. Adjacent to each WIM station is a display station and a parking pad with a certified scale. State Police troopers can stop the suspected overweight vehicle and confirm the weight.
