Making Memorial Day Travel Easy

Enjoy quick, convenient travel on the Illinois Tollway this Memorial Day holiday.

Temporary construction lane closures will be suspended over the Memorial Day weekend from

noon on Friday, May 28, through 9 a.m. on Tuesday, June 1.

Long-term closures and traffic shifts already in place in construction zones will remain and drivers should follow roadway signs.

[Be aware that Express Lanes on the Veterans Memorial Tollway \(I-355\) bypass local exits.](#) Motorists must still obey the construction zone speed limit of 45 m.p.h. as posted, even if no workers are present.

Easy access to travel information as drivers prepare to travel for Memorial Day celebrations, [Know Before You Go!](#) makes trips faster, easier and more convenient.



Be aware: Illinois State Police will be out in force, conducting roadside safety checks, Click It or Ticket details and Alcohol Countermeasure Enforcement. Troopers also will be looking for distracted drivers.

Your I-PASS: Don't Leave Home Without It

I-PASS can be used on the Chicago Skyway, as well as tollways in Indiana, Ohio, Pennsylvania, New York and more than a dozen states to the east. Bring your transponder along and look for the E-ZPass logo when traveling to save time and eliminate the hassle of scrambling for cash to pay tolls out of state.

Keep in mind that toll rates on other tollway systems may be higher than those on the Illinois Tollway. Be sure to have sufficient account funds and remember to check your balance before your trip. If you use auto-replenish make sure your credit/debit card information, including the expiration date, is accurate.

What's Happening

Beginning the week of May 24, traffic will be split in both directions north of the Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) with two Local Lanes traveling in the right outside lanes and an Express Lane traveling on the left inside shoulder.

Traffic planning to exit at I-88, Butterfield Road, Roosevelt Road, North Avenue and Army Trail Road must remain in the Local Lanes to exit. The next available exit northbound from the Express Lanes is Lake Street; the next southbound exit is Ogden Avenue.

Bridge Work

What's Happening

Work is underway on four of the 24 bridges as part of the Resurfacing & Bridge Repair Project. Currently under construction are two Tollway ramps carrying traffic from northbound I-355 to I-88, the Finley Road Bridge between Ogden Avenue and Lacy Drive and the 75th Street Bridge over I-355.
