

Tri-State Tollway (I-294) Bridge Repairs

The Illinois Tollway has completed repairs on 10 bridges on the Tri-State Tollway (I-294) between I-88 and West Lake Avenue.

Update – Latest Construction Info

Bridge deck repairs began in September on northbound I-294 over the East-West Tollway (I-88) and continued north to West Lake Avenue. Bridge repair work was done overnight to minimize impact to traffic.

Minimizing Impact to Reduce Delays

All lane closures were during off-peak, overnight hours. Lane and shoulder closures were permitted between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. on weekdays and between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. on weekends.

Work Zone Safety

Remember to drive safely in work zones and abide by the 45 m.p.h. speed limit; see the Tollway's Work Zone Safety page at www.illinoistollway.com.

The project started in late September and was completed in November 2005.

- Bridge over Dempster Street
- Bridge over Golf Road
- Bridge over Central Road
- Bridge over West Lake Avenue
