



Fox River Bridge Rehabilitation Project

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Fox River Bridge Rehabilitation Project on the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) has repaired the 50-year-old eastbound and westbound bridge structures over the Fox River. Work began in fall 2009 to begin repairs on the substructure below the bridge. Three lanes will remain open during the project which is scheduled to be complete by the end of summer 2010.

This work is part of the Tollway's \$5.8 billion Congestion-Relief Program – *Open Roads for a Faster Future*.

Construction Update (10-07-10)

As of the week of October 7:

- Traffic traveling over the bridge has been shifted back to the standard, three lane configuration in both directions.
- All work is now complete.

PROJECT INCLUDES

Bridge Repairs

The eastbound and westbound bridge structures over the Fox River between IL Route 31 and IL Route 25 will be repaired, including removal and replacement of expansion joints, repairing pre-cast, pre-stressed concrete beams, substructure repairs, pier cap repairs, and beam end repairs.

PURPOSE

Pertinent Details on Why and How

The Fox River Bridges on the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) are 50-year-old structures. Rehabilitation will provide a longer life for the structures. The Tollway is coordinating work with the City of Elgin, Forest Preserve District of Kane County, and several utilities.



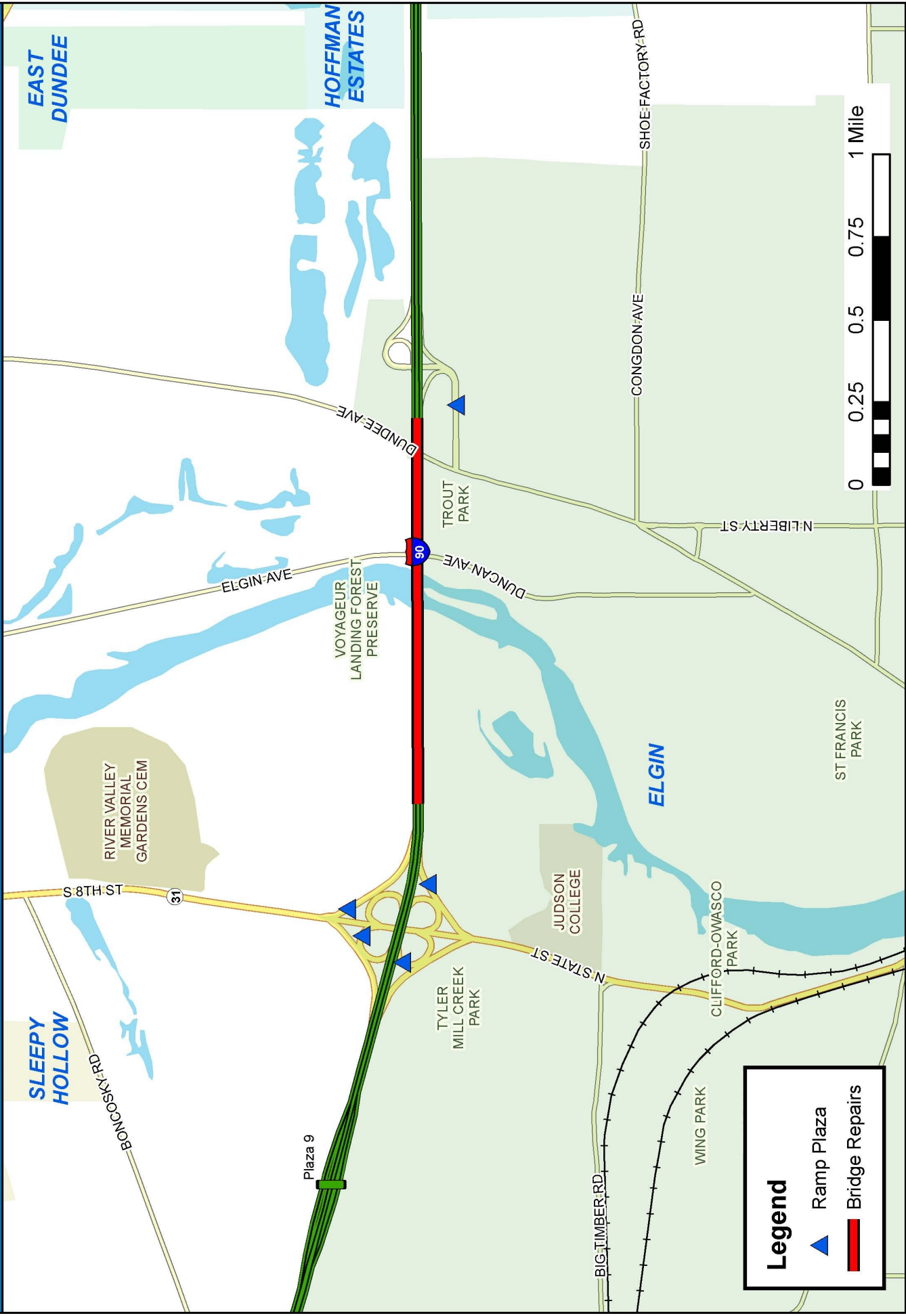
WORK ZONE SAFETY

Construction zone speed limits are in effect in all construction zones 24/7 and drivers should continue to watch for changing traffic patterns and use caution, especially when workers are present.
