Online I-PASS Login - Enhancement Complete

I-PASS Customers Create a Username and Password to Log In

In August 2008, we enhanced our online account log in process, which now requires I-PASS customers to log in to their I-PASS accounts with a username and password. It is important to the Tollway to provide its customers with not only an easier process of logging into their account, but also a more secure and confidential method.

The next time you login to your I-PASS account, you will use the same information as you have in the past to set up your new login information.

1. Username: Account Number or Transponder Number or Email Address
2. Password: PIN Number

Take a New Turn!

In coordination with the Village of Lisle and the Morton Arboretum, the westbound exit ramp to IL Route 53 has been improved. You can now turn right or left from the I-88 westbound exit ramp onto IL Route 53. The old southbound exit to IL Route 53 has closed and a new ramp has opened serving drivers heading both north and south.

No More Potholes! New Lane and Pavement Between York Road and IL Route 83 Westbound Means a Smooth Ride

Westbound traffic is now on new concrete pavement and a third Open Road Tolling (ORT) lane is open at the York Road Toll Plaza. Traffic entering westbound I-88 from the Tri-State Tollway (I-294) ramp now has access to the ORT lanes. New westbound pavement is continuing to be poured every day and will be open to traffic before winter.



North Tri-State Tollway (I-94)

Building Bigger Bridges and Better Roads

We are rebuilding and lengthening the Grand Avenue Bridge over I-94, all traffic will travel on the westbound side of the bridge (one lane in each direction).

In addition, the I-94 southbound ramp exiting to eastbound Grand Avenue has closed and will remain closed until summer 2009. A detour route directs traffic to continue southbound on I-94, exit at Milwaukee Avenue, and then head north to reach Grand Avenue.

High-Volume I-PASS User? More Than One I-PASS Account on Your Account?

Shared Balance Helps Manage Your Money



This fall, just like last year, the Illinois Tollway will automatically review your I-PASS usage totals for the previous six months. If your average monthly usage has changed - higher or lower - the system will create a new replenishment amount for your account. However, those who have requested fixed replenishment rates will not be impacted by this recalculation.

If you are a high-volume user, your account will replenish at a higher rate which may result in fewer transfers from your bank account or credit card. If you have used your I-PASS less this year, your replenishment amount may decrease.

**Please note - minimum amount for automatic replenishment is \$40.00.*
