



Tri-State Tollway (I-294/I-94/I-80) Intermittent Pavement Repairs

The Illinois Tollway has completed pavement repairs on several miles of the Tri-State Tollway (I-294) and the Edens Spur (I-94) to provide a smoother and safer ride for Tollway customers.

Update – Latest Construction Info

Pavement repairs and resurfacing work is now complete in both directions in an 18-mile stretch of the south end of the Tri-State Tollway (I-294/I-80) from I-80 to Joliet Road and in a 40-mile stretch of the north end of the Tri-State (I-294/I-94) from Wolf Road to Mill Creek Road.

Minimizing Impact to Reduce Delays

All work was scheduled during overnight hours to reduce the impact to daytime and weekend traffic. Lane reductions were permitted overnight beginning with one lane after 8 p.m. and a second lane after 10 p.m. All lanes reopened by 5 a.m. each morning.

Work Zone Safety

Remember to drive safely in work zones and abide by the 45 m.p.h. speed limit; see the Tollway's Work Zone Safety page at www.illinoistollway.com.

Schedule

Work began in mid-August on the north end of the Tri-State, from Touhy Avenue to Dundee Road, and in the southbound direction from Washington Street to Balmoral Avenue. In late August, work began on the south end from 159th Street to 95th Street and on the Edens Spur. The project was completed in November.

Sections of pavement were repaired and resurfaced in a 40-mile section of the north Tri-State Tollway (I-294/94), an 18-mile section of the south Tri-State (I-294/80), and the five-mile Edens Spur (I-94) to provide a smoother and safer ride for Tollway customers.
