

Tri-State Tollway (I-294) Bridge Repairs

The Illinois Tollway has completed repairs on 12 bridges on the Tri-State Tollway (I-294) between I-55 and Mannheim Road.

Update – Latest Construction Info

Bridge deck repairs began in June on the Joliet Road ramp bridge to northbound I-294 and on the northbound I-294 bridge over I-88. Bridge repair work was done overnight to minimize impact to traffic.

Minimizing Impact to Reduce Delays

All lane closures were during off-peak, overnight hours. Lane and shoulder closures were permitted between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. on weekdays and between 8 p.m. and 7 a.m. on weekends.

Work Zone Safety

Remember to drive safely in work zones and abide by the 45 m.p.h. speed limit; see the Tollway's Work Zone Safety page at www.illinoistollway.com.

Schedule

The project started in early June and was completed in October 2007.

The bridges that were repaired include:

- Southbound bridge over Roosevelt Road
- Northbound bridge over I-88
- Northbound and southbound bridges over Butterfield Road
- Northbound bridge over Electric Avenue
- Northbound bridge over Union Pacific Railroad
- Three southbound bridges over Union Pacific Railroad
- Northbound and southbound bridges over Salt Creek
- Joliet Road ramp bridge to northbound I-294

Purpose

To complete bridge maintenance, including but not limited to partial and full depth bridge deck repairs, expansion joint replacement and placement of concrete overlays.
