

Reagan Memorial Tollway (I-88) Roadway Resurfacing

The Illinois Tollway has resurfaced four miles of eastbound pavement on the Reagan Memorial Tollway from IL Route 47 to IL Route 56. Resurfaced pavement provides a smoother, safer ride for Tollway customers.

Update – Latest Construction Info

Work to grind the old asphalt pavement and resurface the left lane and shoulder between IL Route 47 and IL Route 56 was completed in early October. After the resurfacing work on the left lane and shoulder was completed, traffic shifted to the new pavement and resurfacing work began on the right lane and shoulder. The project was completed in late October.

Minimizing Impact to Reduce Delays

Two lanes of traffic were available throughout the project to minimize the impact to traffic. One eastbound lane and one shoulder between IL Route 47 and IL Route 56 remained open during the resurfacing work. Ramps remained open to traffic at the IL Route 47 and IL Route 56 interchanges.

Work Zone Safety

Schedule

Work began in early October with the grinding of old asphalt pavement in the left lane and shoulder. After the left lane and shoulder were resurfaced, traffic shifted to the new pavement and work began on the right lane and shoulder. The project was completed in late October.

The asphalt surface was removed and replaced in a four-mile section on the Reagan Memorial Tollway to provide a smoother and safer ride for Tollway customers.
