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Subject: PERMANENT PAVEMENT MARKINGS

The Tollway is currently evaluating different pavement marking materials for use on the Tollway system and will be establishing revised pavement marking standards in the near future. As such, for all current construction projects the Construction Managers shall direct their respective contractors to surface apply (no grooving) the permanent pavement markings.

This directive applies to those projects that are constructed with Portland cement pavements (CRCP and PJCP). For those projects that are constructed with bituminous pavement, the pavement shall be grooved to accept the permanent pavement markings. Polyurea pavement markings shall not be used on bituminous pavement of any type. If polyurea is called for in the plans, please contact your Tollway Project Manager for direction on materials to be used.
