The Illinois Tollway has received your FOIA request for the following:

- Requesting copies of all the agencies databases.

Response: Your categorical request for copies of all the agencies databases would be unduly burdensome on the agency and the burden on the agency vastly outweighs the public interest in the information. As the Tollway requested that you narrow your previous request and you responded with an even broader request, the Tollway's offer to narrow the request looks to be futile. Nonetheless, the Tollway invites you to narrow the request to a manageable proportion. Currently, the Tollway has numerous databases on different platforms that contain well over 60 terabytes of records. Most of the databases contain employee information, customer information and other types of confidential and private information that cannot be disclosed by both state and federal law. Any search of the databases for information that could be disclosed would take weeks to months of searching and evaluating whether the information can be disclosed due to the volume of the data. See 5 ILCS 140/3(g).
