

## **Northwest Tollway (I-90) Roadway Resurfacing**

The Illinois Tollway has completed resurfacing nine miles of pavement on the Northwest Tollway from Newburg Road to Swanson Road, and constructing two median crossovers in Winnebago County. Resurfacing pavement provides a smoother, safer ride for Tollway customers.

### **Update – Latest Construction Info**

Construction of the two median crossovers and resurfacing between Newburg Road and Swanson Road is completed.

### **Minimizing Impact to Reduce Delays**

All work was scheduled during overnight hours to reduce the impact to daytime and weekend traffic. All lanes were opened the following day by 6:30 a.m. to minimize impact to traffic.

### **Work Zone Safety**

### **Schedule**

Work began in early October with the construction of the two median crossovers and resurfacing on the far west end from Swanson Road to Rock Cut State Park. The project was completed in December 2005.

### **Purpose – Pertinent Details on Why and How**

The asphalt surface was removed and replaced in a nine-mile section on the far north end of the Northwest Tollway to provide a smoother and safer ride for Tollway customers. Two median crossovers were constructed as part of this contract to be used in 2006 when IDOT begins a project to build an interchange at IL Route 173.
