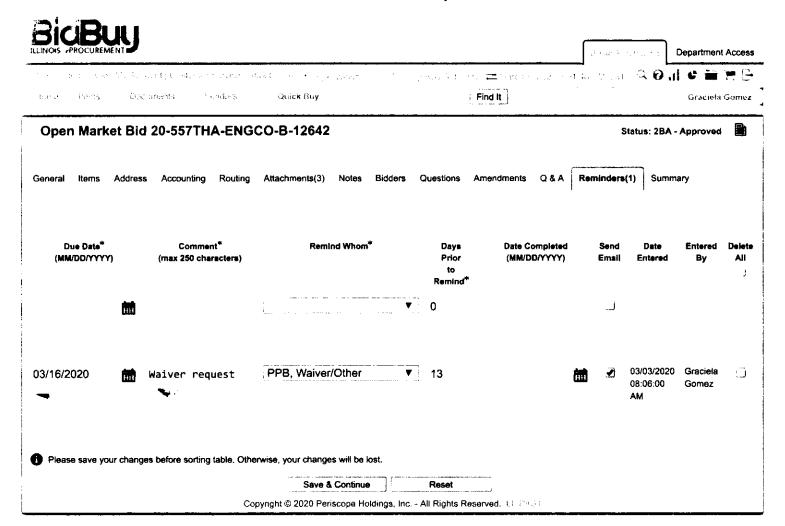

DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

The Board of Directors, on the 16th day of January, 2020, authorized this FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT to be entered into by and between THE ILLINOIS STATE TOLL HIGHWAY AUTHORITY, an instrumentality and administrative agency of the State of Illinois, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "TOLLWAY", and TERRA ENGINEERING, LTD., a corporation authorized and existing within the laws of the State of Illinois, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the TOLLWAY selected the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER from PSB 17-3, Item 14, and DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER entered into an agreement on October 26, 2017, to provide design section engineering services (hereinafter "Services"") for Contract No. I-17-4309 for Tri-State Tollway, Advanced MOT Rehabilitation, 95th Street (Mile Post 17.8) to East West Connector (Mile Post 29.1); and

WHEREAS, additional supplemental Services are necessary due to the increased scope of the work; and

WHEREAS, DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER has submitted a proposal dated **December 2, 2019**, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "1", to provide said additional Services, and it is in the best interest of the TOLLWAY to accept said proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto mutually covenant and agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

General Provisions

The supplemental proposal attached as Exhibit "1" is hereby made a part of this Supplemental Agreement.

The auditors reserve the right to enter the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's place of business in order to audit the records. If they are not produced in
