Background

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority ("Tollway"), pursuant to Resolution No. 21338 approved August 24, 2017, entered into an Agreement with exp U.S. Services, Inc. on Contract No. I-17-4676 for Design Services on the Elgin O'Hare Western Access Tollway (I-490) from Mile Post 5.8 (Touhy Avenue) to Mile Post 6.2 (Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) System Interchange).

The Chairman/Chief Executive Officer of the Tollway is authorized to execute the Agreement, subject to the approval of the Chief Financial Officer, and the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to issue warrants in payment thereof.

DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

The Board of Directors, on the **25**th day of **June**, **2020**, authorized this **FIRST** SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT to be entered into by and between THE ILLINOIS STATE TOLL HIGHWAY AUTHORITY, an instrumentality and administrative agency of the State of Illinois, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "TOLLWAY", and **EXP U.S. SERVICES, INC.**, a **corporation** authorized and existing within the laws of the State of Illinois, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the TOLLWAY selected the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER from PSB 17-2, Item 3, and DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER entered into an agreement on August 24, 2017, to provide design section engineering services (hereinafter "Services"") for Contract No. I-17-4676 for Elgin O'Hare Western Access, Jane Addams Memorial Tollway System Interchange; and

WHEREAS, additional supplemental Services are necessary due to the increased scope of the work; and

WHEREAS, DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER has submitted a proposal dated **May 26**, **2020**, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "1", to provide said additional Services, and it is in the best interest of the TOLLWAY to accept said proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto mutually covenant and agree as follows:

ARTICLE I

General Provisions

Except as modified or changed herein, all terms, provisions and conditions contained in the original agreement between the TOLLWAY and the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER dated **August 24, 2017** ("Original Agreement") and commonly referred to as Contract No. **I-17-4676**, shall govern this agreement and be in full force and effect, however, any changes to multipliers, unit costs, prices and/or rates of compensation shall only be applied to Services rendered solely under this Supplement pursuant to changes in the scope of work. The supplemental proposal attached as Exhibit "1" is hereby made a part of this Supplemental Agreement.

ARTICLE II

Time of Performance

The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall perform the services herein until the latest of the end date of the original agreement, the end date of the most recent supplemental agreement, the end date of any previously approved contract renewal or

amendment or the last day of the last month of the last year of the schedule included at Exhibit "A" in the attached proposal.

ARTICLE III

Reaffirmation of Original Agreement

All covenants and agreements contained in the Original Agreement made and entered into by and between the TOLLWAY and DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER and all prior Supplemental Agreements, if any, to provide Services for Contract No. I-17-4676 for Elgin O'Hare Western Access, Jane Addams Memorial Tollway System Interchange are reaffirmed and shall govern this Agreement as if fully set forth herein, it being the intent that this Agreement shall be a supplement to said agreement(s).

ARTICLE IV

Record Retention and Audit

In compliance with the Illinois Procurement Code (30 III. Comp. Stat. 500/20-65) and rules promulgated thereunder, every CONTRACT for goods and services shall provide that the contractor shall maintain certain records, books and documents.

The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall maintain in the State of Illinois, for a minimum of five years from the latter of the date of completion of the CONTRACT or the date of final payment under the CONTRACT, adequate books, records, and supporting documents from an accounting system maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles to verify the amounts, recipients, uses and methods of all disbursements of funds passing in conjunction with the CONTRACT. The five year record maintenance period shall be extended for the duration of any audit in progress at the time of that period's expiration. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall at its own expense make such records available in a timely manner for inspection and audit (including copies and extracts of records) as required by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, the Chief Procurement Officer for General Services, the Illinois Department of Transportation, and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents at all reasonable times and without prior notice. For purposes of this section, "timeliness" will be considered production within the time period specified by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, the Chief Procurement Officer for General Services, the Illinois Department of Transportation and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents, but no later than thirty days after a request for records being made unless otherwise agreed to by the parties. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER agrees to cooperate fully with any audit conducted by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, the Chief Procurement Officer for General Services, the Illinois Department of Transportation and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents, and to provide full access to all relevant materials. The auditors reserve the right to enter the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's place of business in order to audit the records. If they are not produced in a timely manner by the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER, then the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY or other State agency for the travel expenses of its auditors in the event that this right is invoked.

The obligations of this Section shall be explicitly included in any subcontracts or agreements formed between the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER and any subcontractors or suppliers of goods and services to the extent that those subcontracts or agreements relate to fulfillment of the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's obligations to the TOLLWAY. Such subcontractor shall be required to comply with the terms and conditions of this Section and the TOLLWAY shall be entitled to enforce a breach of that contract.

Any audit adjustment will be submitted on a final invoice for any underpayment or overpayment to the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER or its subcontractors. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall promptly reimburse the TOLLWAY for any overpayment, or the TOLLWAY at its option may deduct any overpayment from any funds due the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER, whether those funds are due under this contract or other contracts to which the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER is a party either directly with the TOLLWAY or as a subcontractor. In the event the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER fails or refuses to reimburse the TOLLWAY for an overpayment, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall be responsible for all costs, including attorney fees, incurred by the TOLLWAY to collect such overpayment.

Failure to maintain or make available the books, records, and supporting documents required by this Section shall establish a presumption in favor of the TOLLWAY for recovery of any funds paid by the TOLLWAY under the contract for which adequate books, records and supporting documentation are not available to support their purported disbursement.

The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY for the total costs of an audit that identifies significant findings that would benefit the TOLLWAY, including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and other expenses. Significant findings for the purposes of this provision shall be identified as an amount in excess of \$50,000 in aggregate of the audit report or findings of material performance or compliance deficiencies.

If the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER fails to comply with these requirements, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER may be disqualified or suspended from bidding on or working on future contracts.

<u>ARTICLE V</u>

Compensation

The upper limit of compensation for said supplemental Services for Contract No. I-17-4676 for Elgin O'Hare Western Access, Jane Addams Memorial Tollway System Interchange performed by the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER under the Original Agreement and including the services set forth herein, is hereby increased from \$13,398,000.00 by \$450,000.00 to \$13,848,000.00.

ARTICLE VI

Report of a Change in Circumstances

The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER agrees to report to the TOLLWAY as soon as practically possible, but no later than 21 days following any change in facts or circumstances that might impact the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's ability to satisfy its legal or contractual responsibilities and obligations under this contract. Required reports include, but are not limited to changes in the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's IDOT prequalification/Disclosure Forms, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's IDOT prequalification, or any certification or licensing required for this project. Additionally, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER agrees to report to the Tollway within the above timeframe any arrests, indictments, convictions or other matters involving the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER, or any of its principals, that might occur while this contract is in effect. This reporting requirement does not apply to common offenses, including but not limited to minor traffic/vehicle offenses.

Further, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER agrees to incorporate substantially similar reporting requirements into the terms of any and all subcontracts relating to work performed under this agreement. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER agrees to forward or relay to the Tollway any reports received from subcontractors pursuant to this paragraph within 21 days.

Finally, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER acknowledges and agrees that the failure of the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER to comply with this reporting requirement shall constitute a material breach of contract which may result in this contract being declared void.

ARTICLE VII

EXPATRIATED ENTITIES

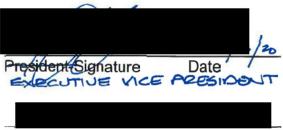

Failure to maintain or make available the books, records, and supporting documents required by this Section shall establish a presumption in favor of the TOLLWAY for recovery of any funds paid by the TOLLWAY under the contract for which adequate books, records and supporting documentation are not available to support their purported disbursement.

The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY for the total costs of an audit that identifies significant findings that would benefit the TOLLWAY, including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and other expenses. Significant findings for the purposes of this provision shall be identified as an amount in excess of \$50,000 in aggregate of the audit report or findings of material performance or compliance deficiencies.

If the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER fails to comply with these requirements, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER may be disqualified or suspended from bidding on or working on future contracts.

<u>INVOICES</u> - INVOICES will be submitted monthly on forms provided to the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER at the start of the project. The invoice cutoff date will coincide with the Monthly Progress Report. All payroll documentation and costs relating to this project will be available for audit by the TOLLWAY upon request.

INVOICES for services performed and expenses incurred through December 31st must be submitted to the TOLLWAY no later than February 28th of the subsequent year. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER expressly acknowledges that the TOLLWAY, at its discretion, reserves the right not to honor any delinquent INVOICE if the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER fails to obtain prior written approval from the Chief Engineering Officer for an alternative INVOICE submission date. DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER will request such approval or an INVOICE submittal extension no later than February 15th.

The Supplemental Engineering Services, more fully detailed in *Exhibit F*, attached hereto, will be executed in conformance with the terms contained in the original agreement for DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's Services except where herein modified.

FEE PROPOSAL

RECORD RETENTION AND AUDIT - In compliance with the Illinois Procurement Code (30 III. Comp. Stat. 500/20-65) and rules promulgated thereunder, every CONTRACT for goods and services shall provide that the contractor shall maintain certain records, books and documents.

The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall maintain in the State of Illinois, for a minimum of five years from the latter of the date of completion of the CONTRACT or the date of final payment under the CONTRACT, adequate books, records, and supporting documents from an accounting system maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles to verify the amounts, recipients, uses and methods of all disbursements of funds passing in conjunction with the CONTRACT. The five year record maintenance period shall be extended for the duration of any audit in progress at the time of that period's expiration. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall at its own expense make such records available in a timely manner for inspection and audit (including copies and extracts of records) as required by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, Chief Procurement Officer, the Illinois Department of Transportation, and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents at all reasonable times and without prior notice. For purposes of this section, "timeliness" will be considered production within the time period specified by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, Chief Procurement Officer, the Illinois Department of Transportation and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents, but no later than thirty days after a request for records being made unless otherwise agreed to by the parties. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER agrees to cooperate fully with any audit conducted by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, Chief Procurement Officer, the Illinois Department of Transportation and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents, and to provide full access to all relevant materials. The auditors reserve the right to enter the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's place of business in order to audit the records. If they are not produced in a timely manner by the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER, then the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY or other State agency for the travel expenses of its auditors in the event that this right is invoked.

The obligations of this Section shall be explicitly included in any subcontracts or agreements formed between the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER and any subcontractors or suppliers of goods and services to the extent that those subcontracts or agreements

relate to fulfillment of the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER's obligations to the TOLLWAY. Such subcontractor shall be required to comply with the terms and conditions of this Section and the TOLLWAY shall be entitled to enforce a breach of that contract.

Any audit adjustment will be submitted on a final invoice for any underpayment or overpayment to the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER or its subcontractors. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall promptly reimburse the TOLLWAY for any overpayment, or the TOLLWAY at its option may deduct any overpayment from any funds due the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER, whether those funds are due under this contract or other contracts to which the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER is a party either directly with the TOLLWAY or as a subcontractor. In the event the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER fails or refuses to reimburse the TOLLWAY for an overpayment, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall be responsible for all costs, including attorney fees, incurred by the TOLLWAY to collect such overpayment.

Failure to maintain or make available the books, records, and supporting documents required by this Section shall establish a presumption in favor of the TOLLWAY for recovery of any funds paid by the TOLLWAY under the contract for which adequate books, records and supporting documentation are not available to support their purported disbursement.

The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY for the total costs of an audit that identifies significant findings that would benefit the TOLLWAY, including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and other expenses. Significant findings for the purposes of this provision shall be identified as an amount in excess of \$50,000 in aggregate of the audit report or findings of material performance or compliance deficiencies.

If the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER fails to comply with these requirements, the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER may be disqualified or suspended from bidding on or working on future contracts.

<u>INVOICES</u> - INVOICES will be submitted monthly on forms provided to the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER at the start of the project. The invoice cutoff date will coincide with the Monthly Progress Report. All payroll documentation and costs relating to this project will be available for audit by the TOLLWAY upon request.

INVOICES for services performed and expenses incurred through December 31st must be submitted to the TOLLWAY no later than February 28th of the subsequent year. The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER expressly acknowledges that the TOLLWAY, at its discretion, reserves the right not to honor any delinquent INVOICE if the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER fails to obtain prior written approval from the Chief Engineering Officer for an alternative INVOICE submission date. DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER will request such approval or an INVOICE submittal extension no later than February 15th.

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EXHIBIT "1"

PARTIAL PAYMENTS

Partial payments to the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER shall be made in accordance with the terms of the original agreement except that reference to the Total Estimated Fee and Upper Limit of Compensation, shall be interpreted to be the Amended Total Estimated Fee and Amended Upper Limit of Compensation.

REVISIONS TO SUPPLEMENTAL SCOPE OF WORK

The scope of supplemental work shall be as detailed in *Exhibit F*. All requirements of the SCOPE OF WORK contained in the original agreement for services shall apply to this supplemental work as well.

EXHIBIT F SCOPE OF WORK

The DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER (DSE) agrees to perform, at the direction of the ILLINOIS TOLLWAY, the following additional services as part of Supplement 1:

PARCEL NW-7B-12-010 RETENTION BASIN

The alignment for Proposed Ramp X4 (Northbound I-490 to Westbound I-90) for the I-490/I-90 System Interchange will impact an existing private retention basin on Parcel NW-7B-12-010. The bid documents for Construction Contract I-18-4705 (Contract 4705C) include a reconfiguration of the basin to maintain the existing capacity that keeps the basin off Illinois Tollway Right-of-Way (ROW). During the land acquisition process, the property owner requested design changes to the basin to Contract 4705C that includes revisions to earthwork schedules, grading plans, drainage schedules, cross sections and quantities that reflect these changes to the basin.

PARCEL NW-7B-12-004 PARKING LOT AND DRAINAGE

The alignment for Proposed Ramp X2 (Northbound I-490 to Eastbound I-90) for the I-490/I-90 System Interchange will impact the existing parking lot on Parcel NW-7B-12-004. The bid documents for Contract 4705C include modifications to the parking lot and the existing drainage system that runs along the south side of I-90 within the Illinois Tollway ROW. During the land acquisition process, the property owner requested design changes to the parking lot design and proposed drainage system that are not reflected in the bid documents. The changes include modifications to the proposed drainage system to increase the parking lot area and the addition of curb and gutter. The DSE will prepare a Construction Revision to Contract 4705C that includes revisions to removal plans, proposed plans, fence plans, drainage plans and profiles, drainage schedules, erosion control plans, landscape plans, retaining wall plans, cross sections and quantities that reflect these changes to the site plan.

WETLAND GRADING

As part of the Intergovernmental Agreement process, the Chicago Department of Aviation (CDA) requested that the Illinois Tollway complete wetland grading on CDA property based on a wetland delineation completed by CDA. This work was included in the bid documents for Contract 4705C. Subsequent to bid opening, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) completed a new delineation of these wetlands. The DSE will prepare a Construction Revision to Contract 4705C that includes revisions to the erosion control plans and quantities.

FIRE SUPPRESSION MEASURES – I-490 BRIDGES OVER MWRD

EXP has prepared a Fire Protection Memorandum for the I-490 Bridges over MWRD. With the bridge lengths over 1,000', the memorandum recommends adding fire suppression measures (accessible fire hydrants) near the bridge abutments. The fire hydrants will tie into a local water distribution system owned and maintained by the City of Des Plaines. The concept plan includes two watermain extensions, one from south of Touhy Avenue that is expected to be constructed as part of a future mainline contract (N07) and one from Jarvis Avenue that is expected to be added to Contract 4705C. The Des Plaines Public Works and Fire Protection District recently concurred with the concept plan.

As requested by the City of Des Plaines, the DSE will model the proposed water distribution systems with the proposed fire hydrants. The modeling will consist of head loss calculations

from the tie-in points. The City of Des Plaines will provide water main pressures at the existing fire hydrants near the tie-in points. The concept plan will be updated based on the modeling results. The concept plan will continue to be coordinated with the Illinois Tollway, GEC, DCM, and the Des Plaines Public Works and Fire Protection District.

When the Concept Plan is approved, the DSE will prepare the Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) for the water main extension. The DSE will prepare a Construction Revision to Contract 4705C that includes grading plans, water main plans, details, special provisions and quantities for the extension from Jarvis Avenue. The DSE will prepare the water main plans, details, special provisions and quantities for the extension from south of Touhy Avenue for inclusion in a separate contract prepared BY OTHERS. The DSE will prepare an IEPA permit for the work.

HIGGINS CREEK BANK STABILIZATION

As part of the Intergovernmental Agreement process, the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (MWRDGC) requested that the Illinois Tollway complete Higgins Creek bank stabilization work in areas exhibiting erosion in the vicinity of the proposed I-490 Bridges over Higgins Creek.

The DSE will prepare the Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) for a separate Contract to complete creek bank stabilization work that includes the following:

TITLE SHEET

Design of this project will be in English Units.

NOTES / INDEX / STANDARDS

The index of sheets will list each sheet included in the plan sheet. ILLINOIS TOLLWAY and IDOT Standards included with the plans will be listed in numerical order. Standard general notes customized to suit the project needs will be shown.

SUGGESTED CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Suggested Construction Schedule Plans will be developed.

SUMMARY OF QUANTITIES

Summary of Quantities sheets shall include a list of pay items with their respective quantities.

EARTHWORK SCHEDULES

Earthwork schedules will be prepared on modified ILLINOIS TOLLWAY Earthwork Schedule Sheets.

ALIGNMENT AND TIES

Horizontal alignment data, alignment ties, state plane coordinate system data, and benchmarks shall be included on the Alignment and Ties sheet.

TYPICAL SECTIONS

Existing and proposed typical sections will be provided for creek bank stabilization.

CREEK BANK STABILIZATION PLANS

The creek bank stabilization work will be shown on plan drawings and will include pay items and work limits.

SEDIMENT AND EROSION CONTROL PLANS

Temporary erosion control methods and procedures to be shown on the plans for each stage of construction in accordance with the applicable IDOT and ILLINOIS TOLLWAY Standards.

Permanent erosion control measures to be shown on the plans to prevent erosion and sedimentation, these plans to include, outlet and channel protection measures, etc. ILLINOIS TOLLWAY and local erosion control criteria shall be utilized.

CROSS SECTIONS

Cross Sections will be prepared at 100 ft. intervals along Higgins Creek within the creek bank stabilization limits. The Cross Sections will include a summary of cuts and fills required per section

SPECIAL PROVISIONS

Check sheets in IDOT Supplemental Specifications and Recurring Special Provisions will be used to identify the special provisions used in the project.

Special Provisions will be provided for items not covered in IDOT Standard Specifications and Supplemental Specifications.

OPINION OF PROBABLE COST

An opinion of Probable Cost will be prepared and included with each submittal: Preliminary, Pre-Final and Final.

PERMITS

The Subconsultant agrees to assist the DESIGN SECTION ENGINEER (DSE) with the following additional services as part of Supplement 1:

WETLAND GRADING

As part of the Intergovernmental Agreement process, the Chicago Department of Aviation (CDA) requested that the Illinois Tollway complete wetland grading on CDA property based on a wetland delineation completed by CDA. This work was included in the bid documents for Contract 4705C. Subsequent to bid opening, the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) completed a new delineation of these wetlands. The DSE will prepare a Construction Revision to Contract 4705C that includes revisions to the erosion control plans and quantities.

FIRE SUPPRESSION MEASURES - I-490 BRIDGES OVER MWRD

EXP has prepared a Fire Protection Memorandum for the I-490 Bridges over MWRD. With the bridge lengths over 1,000', the memorandum recommends adding fire suppression measures (accessible fire hydrants) near the bridge abutments. The fire hydrants will tie into a local water distribution system owned and maintained by the City of Des Plaines. The concept plan includes two watermain extensions, one from south of Touhy Avenue that is expected to be constructed as part of a future mainline contract (N07) and one from Jarvis Avenue that is expected to be added to Contract 4705C. The Des Plaines Public Works and Fire Protection District recently concurred with the concept plan.

As requested by the City of Des Plaines, the DSE will model the proposed water distribution systems with the proposed fire hydrants. The modeling will consist of head loss calculations from the tie-in points. The City of Des Plaines will provide water main pressures at the existing fire hydrants near the tie-in points. The concept plan will be updated based on the modeling results. The concept plan will continue to be coordinated with the Illinois Tollway, GEC, DCM, and the Des Plaines Public Works and Fire Protection District.

When the Concept Plan is approved, the DSE will prepare the Plans, Specifications and Estimates (PS&E) for the water main extension. The DSE will prepare a Construction Revision to Contract 4705C that includes grading plans, water main plans, details, special provisions and quantities for the extension from Jarvis Avenue. The DSE will prepare the water main plans, details, special provisions and quantities for the extension from south of Touhy Avenue for inclusion in a separate contract prepared BY OTHERS. The DSE will prepare an IEPA permit for the work.
