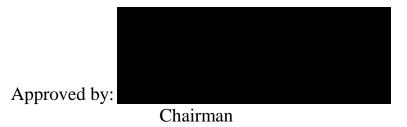
Background

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority ("Tollway"), pursuant to Resolution No 21536 approved April 26, 2018, entered into an Agreement with Thomas Engineering Group, LLC on Contract No. RR-16-4275 for Construction Management Services on the Tri-State Tollway (I-294), Mile Post 40.0 (Balmoral Avenue) to Mile Post 52.9 (Lake-Cook Road).

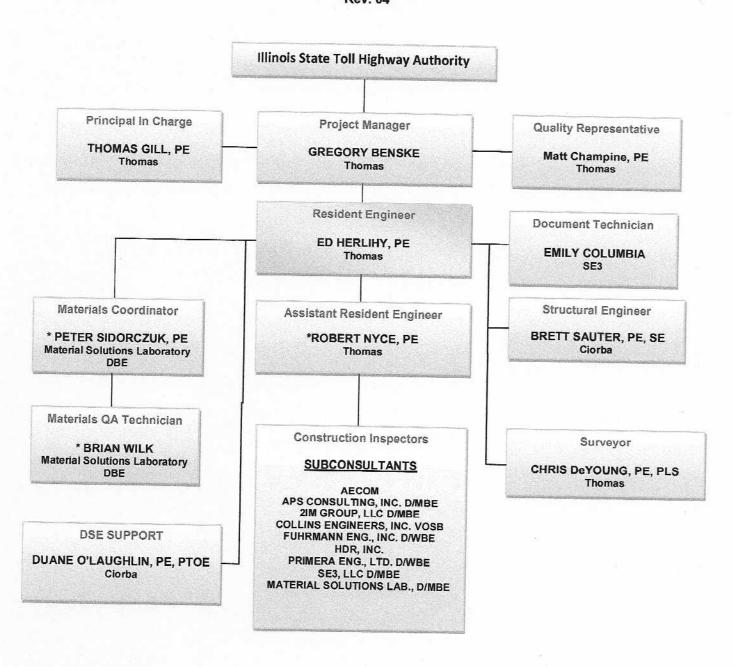

SCOPE OF SUPPLEMENTAL CONSTRUCTION MANAGER SERVICES

The Supplemental Engineering Services, more fully detailed in *Exhibit F*, attached hereto, will be executed in conformance with the terms contained in the original agreement for Construction Manager's Services except where herein modified.

FEE PROPOSAL

The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall be compensated for these Supplemental Engineering Services on the following basis:

ACTUAL PAYROLL COSTS TIMES A MULTIPLIER, PLUS REIMBURSEMENT OF DIRECT EXPENSES, WITH AN UPPER LIMIT OF COMPENSATION.

<u>ACTUAL PAYROLL COSTS AND MULTIPLIER</u> - During the course of the project, compensation shall be equal to Actual Direct Labor Costs (less overtime premium) multiplied by a factor of 2.80 to compensate for **Payroll Burden and Fringe Costs**, **Overhead and Miscellaneous Indirect Costs and Profit.** This factor shall be used

"Actual Direct Labor" shall be reimbursed only for actual payroll costs paid to individuals employed directly by the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, while independent contractors and contract employees shall be treated as "reimbursable direct costs" and not "actual direct salary." Subcontractors shall be treated as "Services by Others."

AGREEMENT LIMITS

The following limits contained in the existing agreement are amended as follows:

The Upper Limit Compensation shall be increased

from $\frac{7,001,011.80}{1,725,600.00}$ to $\frac{8,726,611.80}{1,725,600.00}$.

RECORD RETENTION AND AUDIT - In compliance with the Illinois Procurement Code (30 III. Comp. Stat. 500/20-65) and rules promulgated thereunder, every CONTRACT for goods and services shall provide that the contractor shall maintain certain records, books and documents.

The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall maintain in the State of Illinois, for a minimum of five years from the latter of the date of completion of the CONTRACT or the date of final payment under the CONTRACT, adequate books, records, and supporting documents from an accounting system maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles to verify the amounts, recipients, uses and methods of all disbursements of funds passing in conjunction with the CONTRACT. The five year record maintenance period shall be extended for the duration of any audit in progress at the time of that period's expiration. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall at its own expense make such records available in a timely manner for inspection and audit (including copies and extracts of records) as required by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, Chief Procurement Officer, the Illinois Department of Transportation, and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents at all reasonable times and without prior notice. For purposes of this section, "timeliness" will be considered production within the time period specified by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, Chief Procurement Officer, the Illinois Department of Transportation and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents, but no later than thirty days after a request for records being made unless otherwise agreed to by the parties. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER agrees to cooperate fully with any audit conducted by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, Chief Procurement Officer, the Illinois Department of Transportation and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents, and to provide full access to all relevant materials. The auditors reserve the right to enter the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER's place of business in order to audit the records. If they are not produced in a timely manner by the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, then the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY or other State agency for

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the travel expenses of its auditors in the event that this right is invoked.

The obligations of this Section shall be explicitly included in any subcontracts or agreements formed between the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER and any subcontractors or suppliers of goods and services to the extent that those subcontracts or agreements relate to fulfillment of the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER's obligations to the TOLLWAY. Such subcontractor shall be required to comply with the terms and conditions of this Section and the TOLLWAY shall be entitled to enforce a breach of that contract.

Any audit adjustment will be submitted on a final invoice for any underpayment or overpayment to the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER or its subcontractors. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall promptly reimburse the TOLLWAY for any overpayment, or the TOLLWAY at its option may deduct any overpayment from any funds due the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, whether those funds are due under this contract or other contracts to which the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER is a party either directly with the TOLLWAY or as a subcontractor. In the event the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER fails or refuses to reimburse the TOLLWAY for an overpayment, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall be responsible for all costs, including attorney fees, incurred by the TOLLWAY to collect such overpayment.

Failure to maintain or make available the books, records, and supporting documents required by this Section shall establish a presumption in favor of the TOLLWAY for recovery of any funds paid by the TOLLWAY under the contract for which adequate books, records and supporting documentation are not available to support their purported disbursement.

The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY for the total costs of an audit that identifies significant findings that would benefit the TOLLWAY, including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and other expenses. Significant findings for the purposes of this provision shall be identified as an amount in excess of \$50,000 in aggregate of the audit report or findings of material performance or compliance deficiencies.

If the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER fails to comply with these requirements, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER may be disqualified or suspended from bidding on or working on future contracts.

<u>INVOICES</u> - INVOICES will be submitted monthly on forms provided to the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER at the start of the project. The invoice cutoff date will coincide with the Monthly Progress Report. All payroll documentation and costs relating to this project will be available for audit by the TOLLWAY upon request.

INVOICES for services performed and expenses incurred through December 31st must be submitted to the TOLLWAY no later than February 28th of the subsequent year. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER expressly acknowledges that the TOLLWAY, at its discretion, reserves the right not to honor any delinquent INVOICE if the

B. QUALITY ASSURANCE

- 1. Construction management services are required to provide materials testing and quality assurance (QA) for the projects denoted above.
- QA will be in accordance with the Toll Highway Authority (ISTHA) supplemental specifications, applicable contract special provisions, Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) standard specifications and all QC/QA specifications.
- 3. CM will be responsible for QA plant and jobsite testing of asphalt mixtures, concrete mixtures (except concrete mixtures at a precast facility), recycled concrete aggregates, and recycled asphalt aggregates. C. SCHEDULE REVIEW

Supplemental scope of services will be the same as the original negotiated CM contract (Articles I thru IV and Attachment A included herewith) except as noted:

Supplement 01 extends the CM duration to March 24, 2021. The original CM Contract had been negotiated based on a 31 month duration beginning on May 24, 2018 and ending on December 31, 2020 which included 6 weeks of close-out following the Construction End date (Contract I-18-4373 Start Date: 7/5/18, Completion Date 9/20/19; Contract I-18-4374 Start Date: 4/24/19, Completion Date: 9/30/20). Contract I-18-4374 has an approved Time Extension Request (TER-1) extending the contract duration to 2/10/21. Overtime assignments are anticipated for field personnel, but split shifts or second shift duties have not been budgeted in the supplemental agreement. The anticipated overtime for field personnel (average overtime of 100 hours/year/classification) includes limited weekend duties and standard night-time assignments for maintenance of traffic stage changes. The Thomas Engineering Group (TEG) Team is providing approximately eleven full time equivalent staff for field and office tasks from August 2020 thru November 2020 and approximately five full time equivalent staff from December 2020 thru March 2021. This staffing includes one part-time project manager, one resident engineer, one assistant resident engineer, between 1 to 3 part time inspectors as needed. Our subconsultants (SUB) will provide the following staff: one documentation engineer and four to six inspectors as needed. Material testing will be provided by Material Solutions Laboratory equivalent to two staff personnel (one Materials Coordinator and one inspector). The overall construction value of the four contracts is currently \$93 million as determined by executed construction contracts, authorizations and extra work orders.

All document transmittals and written communication from the consultant to the Illinois Tollway must be made electronically via the System. In certain cases where "wet signatures" and/or stamps are required by the Tollway, document transmittals must be made simultaneously via the System for record and by traditional means for paper documents, unless the consultant is directed otherwise in writing by the Tollway. Once stamped/signed documents have been obtained, they must be scanned and uploaded to the System for record.

CONSTRUCTION MANAGER FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT

The Board of Directors, on the **30**th day of **April**, **2020**, authorized this **FIRST** SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT to be entered into by and between THE ILLINOIS STATE TOLL HIGHWAY AUTHORITY, an instrumentality and administrative agency of the State of Illinois, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "TOLLWAY", and **THOMAS ENGINEERING GROUP, LLC**, a **corporation** authorized and existing within the laws of the State of Illinois, hereinafter sometimes referred to as "CONSTRUCTION MANAGER".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the TOLLWAY selected CONSTRUCTION MANAGER from **PSB 18-1**, **Item 6**, and CONSTRUCTION MANAGER entered into an agreement on **April 26**, **2018**, to provide construction management services (hereinafter "Services"") for Contract No. RR-16-4275 for Edens Spur (I-94), Tri-State Tollway (I-294), Roadway and Bridge Reconstruction, **Mile Post 25.2** (Tri-State Tollway), to **Mile Post 30.0** (Edens Expressway); and

WHEREAS, additional supplemental Services are necessary due to the increased scope of the work; and

WHEREAS, CONSTRUCTION MANAGER has submitted a proposal dated **April 10, 2020**, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "1", to provide said additional Services, and it is in the best interest of the TOLLWAY to accept said proposal.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants hereinafter contained, the parties hereto mutually covenant and agree as follows:

<u>ARTICLE I</u>

General Provisions

Except as modified or changed herein, all terms, provisions and conditions contained in the original agreement between the TOLLWAY and the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER dated **April 26, 2018** ("Original Agreement") and commonly referred to as Contract No. **RR-16-4275** and any prior supplements, shall govern this agreement and be in full force and effect, however, any changes to multipliers, unit costs, prices and/or rates of compensation shall only be applied to Services rendered solely under this Supplement pursuant to changes in the scope of work. The supplemental proposal attached as Exhibit "1" is hereby incorporated into and made a part of this **FIRST** Supplemental Agreement.

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ARTICLE II

Time of Performance

The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall perform the services herein until the latest of the end date of the original agreement, the end date of the most recent supplemental agreement, the end date of any previously approved contract renewal or amendment or the last day of the last month of the last year of the schedule included at Exhibit "A" in the attached proposal.

ARTICLE III

Reaffirmation of Original Agreement

All covenants and agreements contained in the Original Agreement made and entered into by and between the TOLLWAY and CONSTRUCTION MANAGER and any and all prior Supplemental Agreements, if any, to provide Services for Contract No. RR-16-4275 for Edens Spur (I-94), Tri-State Tollway (I-294), Roadway and Bridge Reconstruction, Mile Post 25.2 (Tri-State Tollway), to Mile Post 30.0 (Edens Expressway) are reaffirmed and shall govern this Agreement as if fully set forth herein, it being the intent that this Agreement shall be a supplement to said agreement(s).

ARTICLE IV

Record Retention and Audit

In compliance with the Illinois Procurement Code (30 III. Comp. Stat. 500/20-65) and rules promulgated thereunder, every CONTRACT for goods and services shall provide that the contractor shall maintain certain records, books and documents.

The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall maintain in the State of Illinois, for a minimum of five years from the latter of the date of completion of the CONTRACT or the date of final payment under the CONTRACT, adequate books, records, and supporting documents from an accounting system maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles to verify the amounts, recipients, uses and methods of all disbursements of funds passing in conjunction with the CONTRACT. The five year record maintenance period shall be extended for the duration of any audit in progress at the time of that period's expiration. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall at its own expense make such records available in a timely manner for inspection and audit (including copies and extracts of records) as required by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, the Chief Procurement Officer for General Services, the Illinois Department of Transportation, and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents at all reasonable times and without prior notice. For purposes of this section, "timeliness" will be considered production within the time period specified by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, the Chief Procurement Officer for General Services, the Illinois Department of Transportation and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents, but no later than thirty days after a request for records being made unless otherwise agreed to by the parties. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER

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agrees to cooperate fully with any audit conducted by the Auditor General and other State Auditors, the Chief Procurement Officer for General Services, the Illinois Department of Transportation and the TOLLWAY's Inspector General, Internal Audit or other TOLLWAY agents, and to provide full access to all relevant materials. The auditors reserve the right to enter the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER's place of business in order to audit the records. If they are not produced in a timely manner by the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, then the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY or other State agency for the travel expenses of its auditors in the event that this right is invoked.

The obligations of this Section shall be explicitly included in any subcontracts or agreements formed between the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER and any subcontractors or suppliers of goods and services to the extent that those subcontracts or agreements relate to fulfillment of the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER's obligations to the TOLLWAY. Such subcontractor shall be required to comply with the terms and conditions of this Section and the TOLLWAY shall be entitled to enforce a breach of that contract.

Any audit adjustment will be submitted on a final invoice for any underpayment or overpayment to the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER or its subcontractors. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall promptly reimburse the TOLLWAY for any overpayment, or the TOLLWAY at its option may deduct any overpayment from any funds due the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, whether those funds are due under this contract or other contracts to which the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER is a party either directly with the TOLLWAY or as a subcontractor. In the event the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER fails or refuses to reimburse the TOLLWAY for an overpayment, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall be responsible for all costs, including attorney fees, incurred by the TOLLWAY to collect such overpayment.

Failure to maintain or make available the books, records, and supporting documents required by this Section shall establish a presumption in favor of the TOLLWAY for recovery of any funds paid by the TOLLWAY under the contract for which adequate books, records and supporting documentation are not available to support their purported disbursement.

The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER shall reimburse the TOLLWAY for the total costs of an audit that identifies significant findings that would benefit the TOLLWAY, including but not limited to reasonable attorney's fees and other expenses. Significant findings for the purposes of this provision shall be identified as an amount in excess of \$50,000 in aggregate of the audit report or findings of material performance or compliance deficiencies.

If the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER fails to comply with these requirements, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER may be disqualified or suspended from bidding on or working on future contracts.

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ARTICLE VI

Compensation

The upper limit of compensation for said supplemental Services for Contract No. RR-16-4275 for Edens Spur (I-94), Tri-State Tollway (I-294), Roadway and Bridge Reconstruction, Mile Post 25.2 (Tri-State Tollway), to Mile Post 30.0 (Edens Expressway) performed by the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER under the Original Agreement and including the services set forth herein, is hereby increased from \$ 7,001,011.80 by \$ 1,725,600.00 to \$ 8,726,611.80.

ARTICLE VII

Report of a Change in Circumstances

The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER agrees to report to the TOLLWAY as soon as practically possible, but no later than 21 days following any change in facts or circumstances that might impact the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER's ability to satisfy its legal or contractual responsibilities and obligations under this contract. Required reports include, but are not limited to changes in the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER's Certification/Disclosure Forms, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER's IDOT prequalification, or any certification or licensing required for this project. Additionally, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER agrees to report to the Tollway within the above timeframe any arrests, indictments, convictions or other matters involving the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER, or any of its principals, that might occur while this contract is in effect. This reporting requirement does not apply to common offenses, including but not limited to minor traffic/vehicle offenses.

Further, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER agrees to incorporate substantially similar reporting requirements into the terms of any and all subcontracts relating to work performed under this agreement. The CONSTRUCTION MANAGER agrees to forward or relay to the Tollway any reports received from subcontractors pursuant to this paragraph within 21 days.

Finally, the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER acknowledges and agrees that the failure of the CONSTRUCTION MANAGER to comply with this reporting requirement shall constitute a material breach of contract which may result in this contract being declared void.

ARTICLE VIII

EXPATRIATED ENTITIES

Except in limited circumstances, no business or member of a unitary business group, as defined in the Illinois Income Tax Act, shall submit a bid for or enter into a contract with a State agency if that business or any member of the unitary business group is an expatriated entity.

CM will be responsible for QA plant and jobsite testing of asphalt mixtures, concrete mixtures (except concrete mixtures at a precast facility), recycled concrete aggregates, and recycled asphalt aggregates. The CM is also is also responsible for off-site and job site testing of embankment materials.

C. SCHEDULE REVIEW

- 1. The CM shall review the qualifications of the Contractor's proposed Scheduler as submitted at the Preconstruction Meeting, and recommend approval or rejection to the Tollway as appropriate.
- The CM shall review, analyze, and provide comments/recommendations to the Tollway regarding the Contractor's proposed Baseline Schedule, Revised Baseline Schedule (RBS), and Monthly Schedule Updates (MSU) within 5 days of submittal by the Contractor.
- 3. The CM shall be sufficiently familiar with the Plans to determine that the Contractor's Baseline and MSU reflect the actual developing site conditions, optimize critical path durations, and make the most efficient use of the resources allotted for the Work.
- 4. It shall be the responsibility of the CM to review the MSU's to verify that progress on the controlling items is maintained. If progress is behind schedule or if a significant number of items are approaching criticality, the CM shall recommend that the Tollway require that a RBS be submitted by the Contractor, pursuant to the Progress Schedule Requirements, Article 108.02 (b).
- 5. The CM shall monitor construction progress, particularly as it compares to the Contractor's approved Baseline Schedule, RBS, and MSU, as applicable. The CM review of the Contractor's Baseline schedule submission should include review as described in the CM Manual.
- 6. The CM is required to follow the Construction Schedule Review (CSR) in the Web-based Project Management System to manage the review of all Contractor's schedule submissions including the Baseline, the Revised Baseline Schedule, and the Monthly Schedule Updates.
- 7. The CM is to follow the Time Extension Request process in the Webbased Project Management System to manage the review and processing of all Contractor time extension requests.

III. REQUIRED SUBMITTALS TO THE AUTHORITY

Submittal requirements shall be in accordance with the CM Manual.

IV. ITEMS TO BE FURNISHED TO THE CONSTRUCTION MANAGER

In addition to the items to be provided as described in the CM Manual, the following will be supplied:

1. It shall be the responsibility of the CM to select the applicable reduced record drawings from the Tollway's GIS Site.

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- 2. Digital Ortho-Imagery, contours, horizontal and vertical survey control and center line of the project limits.
- 3. Copies of ISTHA Standard Specifications, Standard Drawings, and ISTHA Design Criteria can be obtained from the Tollway's website.
- 4. Copy of contract documents for contracts referenced in Section I, above.

Supplemental scope of services will be the same as the original negotiated CM contract (Articles I thru IV and Attachment A included herewith) except as noted:

Supplement 01 extends the CM duration to March 24, 2021. The original CM Contract had been negotiated based on a 31 month duration beginning on May 24, 2018 and ending on December 31, 2020 which included 6 weeks of close-out following the Construction End date (Contract I-18-4373 Start Date: 7/5/18, Completion Date 9/20/19; Contract I-18-4374 Start Date: 4/24/19, Completion Date: 9/30/20). Contract I-18-4374 has an approved Time Extension Request (TER-1) extending the contract duration to 2/10/21. Overtime assignments are anticipated for field personnel, but split shifts or second shift duties have not been budgeted in the supplemental agreement. The anticipated overtime for field personnel (average overtime of 100 hours/year/classification) includes limited weekend duties and standard night-time assignments for maintenance of traffic stage changes. The Thomas Engineering Group (TEG) Team is providing approximately eleven full time equivalent staff for field and office tasks from August 2020 thru November 2020 and approximately five full time equivalent staff from December 2020 thru March 2021. This staffing includes one part-time project manager, one resident engineer, one assistant resident engineer, between 1 to 3 part time inspectors as needed. Our subconsultants (SUB) will provide the following staff: one documentation engineer and four to six inspectors as needed. Material testing will be provided by Material Solutions Laboratory equivalent to two staff personnel (one Materials Coordinator and one inspector). The overall construction value of the four contracts is currently \$93 million as determined by executed construction contracts, authorizations and extra work orders.

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Attachment A

Web-based Project Management System

The Illinois Tollway has a Web-based Project Management System (System) that will be used by project participants on Tollway projects. The System provides a number of benefits to the project participants, including:

- 1) Simplification of communications/online collaboration.
- 2) Automated tracking of time-sensitive items.

The successful consultant must establish broadband Internet connectivity in order to effectively utilize the System (T1 is recommended) and must comply with all work instructions and procedures relating to its use. The consultant must furnish all hardware and software required to effectively utilize the System, including personal computers, peripheral software, virus protection software, System plug-ins, ActiveX installation, firewall configuration and high-speed document scanners. The consultant will be solely responsible for coordination between its subconsultants & suppliers, and the System. All document transmittals and written communication from the consultant to the Illinois Tollway must be made electronically via the System. In certain cases where "wet signatures" and/or stamps are required by the Tollway, document transmittals must be made simultaneously via the System for record and by traditional means for paper documents, unless the consultant is directed otherwise in writing by the Tollway. Once stamped/signed documents have been obtained, they must be scanned and uploaded to the System for record.

All consultant, subconsultant and supplier employees who will use the web-based system must complete the training provided by the Tollway prior to receiving access to the system. A valid email address must be provided prior to training session. The consultant agrees to comply with all terms and conditions associated with use of the web-based project management system.

- 1.0 Consultant shall utilize ISTHA web based project management system to track and manage projects. System shall be an official record of all project communication. Consultant shall post copies of all project related documents on the System.
- **2.0** Within 14 calendar days of Notice to Proceed, Consultant shall designate a website manager (coordinator) who is to be the point of contact with ISTHA website implementation and support staff.
- **3.0** Consultant is required but not limited to submit the following using the System:
 - 3.1 Submittal schedule, submittals shall be processed using the System to provide

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- a record of activity.
- 3.2 Progress reports.
- 3.3 Inspection reports.
- 3.4 Requests for information, project clarifications, general communication and project related issues.
- 3.5 Meeting agendas, no later than 3 days before meeting.
- 3.6 Minutes of meetings, no later than 3 days after each progress meeting date, distribute copies of minutes via the System to each party present and to other parties who should have been present. Include a brief summary in narrative form of progress since the previous meeting and report.
- **4.0** Document submission requirements. Project documents transmitted via the System must comply with the following electronic formats:
 - 4.1 Documents that are marked up or unavailable in electronic format (drawings, sketches, correspondence, etc. generated by hand drafting methods) shall be scanned to PDF (.pdf), black and white with maximum resolution of 200dpi using CCITT Group 4 (2d Fax) compression.
 - 4.2 Documents that have been generated using Adobe Acrobat PDF printer drivers (not scanned) shall be submitted to the System.
 - 4.3 Electronic photographs shall be submitted in JPEG (.JPG) file format, sized at a minimum resolution of 1024x768 pixels.

BLANKET ADDITIONAL INSURED (ARCHITECTS, ENGINEERS AND SURVEYORS)

This endorsement modifies insurance provided under the following:

COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY COVERAGE PART

 The following is added to SECTION II – WHO IS AN INSURED:

Any person or organization that you agree in a "written contract requiring insurance" to include as an additional insured on this Coverage Part, but:

- a. Only with respect to liability for "bodily injury", "property damage" or "personal injury"; and
- b. If, and only to the extent that, the injury or damage is caused by acts or omissions of you or your subcontractor in the performance of "your work" to which the "written contract requiring insurance" applies, or in connection with premises owned by or rented to you.

The person or organization does not qualify as an additional insured:

- **c.** With respect to the independent acts or omissions of such person or organization; or
- d. For "bodily injury", "property damage" or "personal injury" for which such person or organization has assumed liability in a contract or agreement.

The insurance provided to such additional insured is limited as follows:

- e. This insurance does not apply on any basis to any person or organization for which coverage as an additional insured specifically is added by another endorsement to this Coverage Part.
- f. This insurance does not apply to the rendering of or failure to render any "professional services".
- g. In the event that the Limits of Insurance of the Coverage Part shown in the Declarations exceed the limits of liability required by the "written contract requiring insurance", the insurance provided to the additional insured shall be limited to the limits of liability required by that "written contract requiring insurance". This endorsement does not increase the limits of insurance described in Section III Limits Of Insurance.

- h. This insurance does not apply to "bodily injury" or "property damage" caused by "your work" and included in the "productscompleted operations hazard" unless the contract reauirina insurance" specifically requires you to provide such coverage for that additional insured, and then the insurance provided to the additional insured applies only to such "bodily injury" or "property damage" that occurs before the end of the period of time for which the "written contract requiring insurance" requires you to provide such coverage or the end of the policy period, whichever is earlier.

3. The following is added to Paragraph 8., Transfer Of Rights Of Recovery Against Others To Us, of SECTION IV – COMMERCIAL GENERAL LIABILITY CONDITIONS:

We waive any right of recovery we may have against any person or organization because of payments we make for "bodily injury", "property damage" or "personal injury" arising out of "your work" performed by you, or on your behalf, done under a "written contract requiring insurance" with that person or organization. We waive this right only where you have agreed to do so as part of the "written contract requiring insurance" with such person or organization signed by you before, and in effect when, the "bodily injury" or "property damage" occurs, or the "personal injury" offense is committed.
