



Options For Illinois Tollway Customers

I-PASS customers pay via existing accounts

- 50 percent discount for cars
- 33 percent discount for trucks

Obtain an I-PASS

Unpaid toll payments

- 7 days to pay online (extended to July 31 for the first month)
- License plate violation search

Fines for unpaid tolls

- \$10 per violation at time of notice
- \$25 per escalated violation





PEAJE PREPAGADO COMIENZA EL 5 DE JULIO, 2016

A partir de **5 de Julio de 2016**, la sección de la Ruta 390 que extiende desde Lake Street hasta el I-290 será únicamente de peaje prepagado.



¡Se extiende el período de pagar durante el mes de Julio!

Durante el mes de Julio, se extenderá el periodo de pagar hasta el 31 de Julio de 2016 para los conductores que no han pagado peaje. Después de esta fecha, el periodo de pagar será solo 7 días.

¿No pagó peaje?

Ya que no habrá casetas ni canastas de cobro a lo largo de la Ruta 390 de Illinois, todos los usuanos tendrán que utilizar un I-PASS. I os conductores que no pagan sus peajes, deberán anotar el nombre o número de la caseta de peaje opunto de milla y pagar por Internet o oor corros antes de los 7 días.





Frontage Roads

Illinois Route 390 Tollway Frontage Road Update

New frontage roads system along Illinois Route 390 Tollway from I-290 to York Road

- New frontage road names "North Thorndale Avenue" and "South Thorndale Avenue"
- Conversion of existing Thorndale Avenue
 - New traffic pattern Summer 2016
 - Final configuration anticipated to be completed late 2017



Frontage Road Naming – North Thorndale Avenue and South Thorndale Avenue

Name based on location of frontage roads <u>north</u> and <u>south</u> of Illinois Route 390 Tollway

Maintain route naming consistency for travelers

Next steps

- Signage to be updated in ongoing construction contracts and design contracts
- Change of address for existing business owners
- DuPage County and municipalities to add new segments of roadway to postal system



Conversion of Existing Thorndale Avenue to Frontage Roads

Traffic on existing Thorndale Avenue will be modified this summer

Local eastbound and westbound traffic will be temporarily routed along portions of existing Thorndale Avenue and new frontage road/mainline roadway segments

Temporary signage will be installed

- One Way
- Do Not Enter
- No Right Turn; No Left Turn

Notification of changing traffic pattern to business owners




2016 Temporary Traffic Flow



Frontage Road Segments Hamilton Lakes Drive to Arlington Heights Road


South Thorndale Avenue (eastbound traffic only)





Frontage Road Segments Arlington Heights Road to Prospect Avenue


North Thorndale Avenue (westbound traffic)

Frontage Road Segments Prospect Avenue to Mittel Drive


North Thorndale Avenue (westbound and eastbound traffic)






Frontage Road Segments Mittel Drive to Supreme Drive

South Thorndale Avenue (eastbound traffic)




Frontage Road Segments Supreme Drive to York Road

Final Configuration of the Frontage Roads

Anticipated to be completed in fall 2017

Tollway to transfer jurisdiction/right of way to DuPage County, Itasca, and Wood Dale for their ultimate jurisdictional responsibilities

Thorndale Avenue to be removed from the County Highway System and new segments of frontage road to be added
