

Tolling Specific Outreach - By the Numbers

- 3 mobile I-PASS sales distribution in the surrounding community
- 370 independent, proactive outreach activities throughout the region
- 19,700 postcards sent to non-I-PASS users
- 46 targeted zip codes received eblast from Illinois Tollway
- 26 Jewel-Osco locations received communications toolkit
- 6+ local access channels ran interviews, PSA, video throughout area

- 462 posters distributed across Pace bus lines
- 61,900 printed materials circulated throughout the region
- 10 PCMS signs providing drivers with up-to-date information on rates and timing
- 13 CCI signs along mainline and access roads
- 130+ communities engaged throughout the region
- 6,000+ distribution list received commercial vehicle notification in Fleeting Moments




I-PASS Sales Spiked Prior to Tolling

Jewel stores located near Illinois Route 390


- Schaumburg

Sales increased from less than 200 per week to 1,000 a week






Cashless Tolling

- Comparison with alternative roadways




Frontage Roads

Illinois Route 390 Tollway Frontage Road Update

New frontage roads system along Illinois Route 390 Tollway from I-290 to York Road

- New frontage road names effective late 2017 "North Thorndale Avenue" and "South Thorndale Avenue"
- Conversion of existing Thorndale Avenue
 - New traffic pattern Summer 2016
 - Final configuration anticipated to be completed late 2017





Conversion of Existing Thorndale Avenue to Frontage Roads


Traffic on existing Thorndale Avenue will be modified this summer in phases

Local eastbound and westbound traffic will be temporarily routed along portions of existing Thorndale Avenue and new frontage road/mainline roadway segments




