



2017 Construction Highlights

Illinois Route 390 Tollway bridge construction

- Prospect Avenue
- Illinois Route 83
- Hamilton Lakes Drive

All mainline lanes and ramps from I-290 to Illinois Route 83 will open in the fall

New interchanges complete

- I-290
- Arlington Heights Road/Prospect Avenue
- Wood Dale Road
- Illinois Route 83

2017 Construction Highlights

Final Thorndale Frontage Roads traffic patterns complete

Two-way traffic segments

- Arlington Heights Road and Hamilton Lakes Drive
- Prospect Ave to Mittel Drive
- Lively Boulevard jog

All other frontage roads segments will remain one-way

Lively Boulevard and Mittel Drive traffic signals will be removed and replaced with stop signs

Thorndale Frontage Roads Address Changes

Thorndale Avenue reconfigured as frontage roads along Illinois Route 390 Tollway

Tenant/businesses with existing Thorndale Avenue addresses to be changed

Frontage Roads to be named:

- North Thorndale Avenue
- South Thorndale Avenue

New addresses will include an east or west designation, i.e. E North Thorndale Avenue

Tollway offering assistance to impacted businesses







Project Overview

GDALS: To create an incremental transit plan for the Illinois Route 390 Tollway Corridor that will increase transit market share, intensify transit oriented land uses and create economic development apportunities for communities

Key Elements


- Integrate Short-term, Medium-term, and Long-term Improvements
- Develop Flexible Approach to Adapt to Changing Environment
- Make Public Transportation Connectivity Seamless
- Build Upon Previous Studies
- Conduct Effective Interagency Coordination

Project Steps

- Existing Conditions & Market Assessment
- Ongoing Public Outreach
 - Technical Advisory Committee
 - Local Advisory Committee
 - Focus Group Meetings with Community Organizations & Local Businesses
- Alternatives Analysis
 - Evaluate corridors of interest identified by previous plans
 - Select most promising corridors for short-, medium-, and long-term development
- Draft & Final Recommendations

Identifying Corridors of Interest

- Starting point is to evaluate proposed corridors from past studies
- 113 corridors from 7 plans identified for evaluation



Corridors for Evaluation

Evaluating Corridors of Interest


- Qualitative & Quantitative
 Criteria refine to most
 promising
- Feedback from Pace, TAC, and Focus Groups

Questions Asked:

- Where are travelers going?
- Where do likely transit users live and work?
- Does existing infrastructure and land use support transit?
- Where is existing transit service?
- What new transit connections are needed?




