Illinois State Police Announce Results of Distracted Driving Enforcement Patrols in Cook, DuPage, Lake and Will Counties

Downers Grove, IL – Illinois State Police District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announced today enforcement figures for Distracted Driving Enforcement Patrols (DDEP) conducted June 23 and June 30 on the Tri-State Tollway (I-94/I-294) in Cook and Lake counties and the Veterans Memorial Tollway (I-355) in DuPage and Will counties.
