Illinois State Police Announce Results of Roadside Safety Check in Cook County

Downers Grove, IL – The Illinois State Police (ISP) announced the results of a Roadside Safety Check (RSC) held in Cook County during the late evening hours of Friday, July 2, 2021, and early morning hours of Saturday, July 3, 2021. The detail was conducted on the northbound Tri-State Tollway (I-294/I-80) at the Halsted Street Toll Plaza in South Holland by ISP District 15 officers.

Alcohol is involved in nearly 40 percent of fatal crashes in Illinois. RSCs are designed to remove alcohol-impaired drivers. However, when other violations are observed such as driving with a suspended or revoked license, operating a vehicle without a valid registration or insurance or safety belt violations, enforcement action may be taken. The following enforcement action was issued at the safety check:

All other alcohol-related violations	2 citations
All other Illinois Vehicle Code offenses	2 citations, 1 warning
