MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH JANUARY 2021

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.




\$9.9 billion or **69.7**% of the program budget committed

\$5.6 billion, or approximately 39.5%, in construction work

52.6 billion, or approximately 18.0%, in consultant services

\$1.6 billion, or approximately 11.6%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$190.2 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.3%









2021 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE - YEAR TO DATE













2021 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE - YEAR TO DATE










ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 AND I-490 BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE











2021 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
