### **MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM**

**DATA THROUGH OCTOBER 2021** 

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.




**\$10.6 billion** or **74.1**% of the program budget committed

**56.1 billion**, or approximately **43.0%,** in construction work

52.8 billion, or approximately 19.6%, in consultant services

\$1.6 billion, or approximately 11.5%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$193.8 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.4%














### 2021 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE - YEAR TO DATE








### **ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 AND I-490 BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE**















### 2021 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
