Drivers may not be thinking about soil as they travel on the Tri-State Tollway (I-94/I-294/I-80). But, if it hadn't been properly tested by a firm specializing in geotechnical work, the roadway might not have been able to support the pavement that gives customers a smooth, comfortable ride.
