### **ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK** **RESULTS IN DUPAGE COUNTY**

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of a Roadside Safety Check (RSC) held in DuPage County from late night Saturday, May 28, 2022, to early morning Sunday, May 29, 2022. The RSC was conducted on the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) eastbound at the Illinois Route 31 Toll Plaza in Elgin by District 15 officers.
