ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK RESULTS IN DUPAGE COUNTY

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of a Roadside Safety Check (RSC) held in DuPage County from late night Wednesday, May 18, 2022, to early morning Thursday, May 19, 2022. The RSC was conducted on the Veterans Memorial Tollway (I-355) northbound at the Butterfield Road Toll Plaza in Downers Grove by District 15 officers.
