### **ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE ROADSIDE SAFETY CHECK** **RESULTS IN DUPAGE COUNTY**

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of a Roadside Safety Check (RSC) held in DuPage County in the early evening of August 27, 2022. The RSC was conducted on the Veterans Memorial Tollway (I-355) southbound at the Boughton Road Toll Plaza in Bolingbrook by District 15 officers.
