### **ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE RESULTS OF OCCUPANT RESTRAINT ENFORCEMENT PATROLS**

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of Occupant Restraint Enforcement Patrols (OREP) held in Cook, DuPage, Kane and Lake counties during the early month of September in and around the Labor Day Holiday. These OREPs provided extra patrol coverage for the ISP so officers could focus on saving lives by making sure all vehicle occupants were buckled up.

Child restraint citations	<b>1 citations</b>
Total citations	<b>91</b>
Total written warnings	<b>34</b>

Most motorists know safety belts save lives, but some ignore their safety and that of their families by neglecting to use safety belts and child restraint devices. These patrols reinforce the occupant protection message by focusing on those who ignore the law.
