ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE RESULTS OF ALCOHOL COUNTERMEASURE ENFORCEMENT PATROLS

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of Alcohol Countermeasure Enforcement (ACE) patrols in DuPage, Cook and Kane counties during the month of October 2022. These ACE patrols allowed the ISP to focus on preventing, detecting and taking enforcement action in response to violations associated with impaired driving and illegal transportation or consumption of alcohol or drugs.
