### **ILLINOIS STATE POLICE TO CONDUCT SPECIAL TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PATROLS AS PART OF THE CLICK IT OR TICKET CAMPAIGN**

DOWNERS GROVE – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the ISP will conduct Special Traffic Enforcement Patrols (sTEP) in Cook, DuPage, Kane and Will counties during the month of November 2022 during the daytime and nighttime hours. These sTEPs allow the ISP to focus on these fatal four violations that contribute the greatest to traffic crashes and fatalities:

- Driving under the influence (DUI)
- Safety belt and child restraint use
- Speeding and
- Distracted driving

The ISP will increase its daytime and nighttime patrols to ensure the safety of vehicle travelers through enforcement of all traffic safety laws. Impaired driving is a factor in more than 30 percent of traffic deaths in Illinois. Likewise, speeding is a factor in nearly 35 percent of fatal crashes and nearly 50 percent of vehicle occupants killed in traffic crashes were known to not be buckled up.
