ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE RESULTS OF SPECIAL TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PATROLS IN COOK, DuPAGE, KANE, LAKE AND WILL COUNTIES

Downers Grove, IL – Illinois State Police (ISP) District 15 Commander Jason Bradley announces the results of Special Traffic Enforcement Patrols (sSTEP) in Cook, DuPage, Kane, Lake and Will counties during November 2022. These sTEPs allowed the ISP to provide increased enforcement for impaired driving, occupant restraint, speeding and distracted driving violations during the National “Click It or Ticket” Campaign.
