

MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH JANUARY 2022

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.

MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2022)

\$10.7 billion or **75.1**% of the program budget committed

56.3 billion, or approximately 44.5%, in construction work

52.8 billion, or approximately 20.0%, in consultant services

\$1.6 billion, or approximately 11.6%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$193.8 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.4%


















CENTRAL TRI-STATE BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE





2022 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE





















2022 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
