

MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH APRIL 2022

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.

MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2022)

\$10.9 billion or **76.3**% of the program budget committed

56.4 billion, or approximately **45%**, in construction work

\$2.9 billion, or approximately **20.3%,** in consultant services

\$1.6 billion, or approximately 11.6%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$193.8 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by **1.4**%















2022 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE










ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 AND I-490 BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE















2022 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
