

MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH MAY 2022

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.

MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2022)

\$10.9 billion or **76.6%** of the program budget committed

\$6.5 billion, or approximately 45.2%, in construction work

52.9 billion, or approximately 20.4%, in consultant services

\$1.6 billion, or approximately 11.6%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$193.8 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.4%















2022 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE





















2022 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
