

MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH AUGUST 2022

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.

MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2022)

\$11.5 billion or 81.0% of the program budget committed

\$7.0 billion, or approximately 49.0%, in construction work

\$2.9 billion, or approximately 20.6%, in consultant services

\$1.6 billion, or approximately 11.7%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$194.0 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.4%






















ILLINOIS ROUTE 390 AND I-490 BUDGET COMMITTED BY PHASE







2022 CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT STATUS













2022 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
