

MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM DATA THROUGH SEPTEMBER 2022


In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.

MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2022)

\$11.8 billion or **83.0%** of the program budget committed

- **57.2 billion**, or approximately **50.5%**, in construction work
- **53.0 billion**, or approximately **21.0%**, in consultant services
- **51.7 billion**, or approximately **11.7%**, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)
- \$209.7 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.5%

68.5% of the *Move Illinois* Program is complete (work in place)






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




The I-490 Tollway, coupled with the new Illinois Route 390 Tollway, will provide 17 miles of new toll roads and direct access to O'Hare International Airport.




