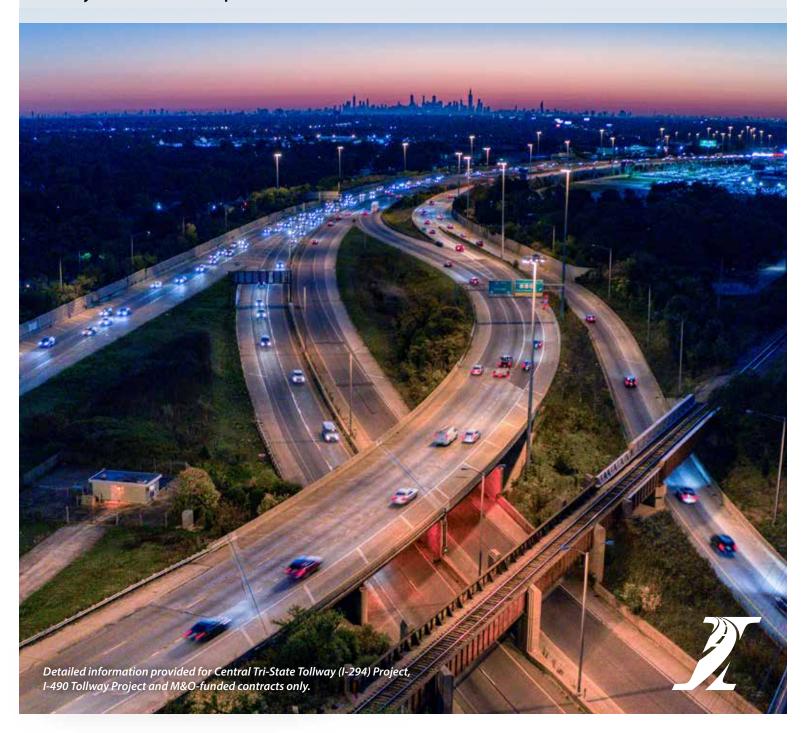

MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH OCTOBER 2022

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.

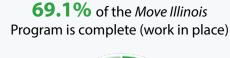
\$11.9 billion or **83.6**% of the program budget committed

51.2%, in construction work

53.0 billion, or approximately 21.0%, in consultant services

\$1.7 billion, or approximately 12.0%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$209.7 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.5%

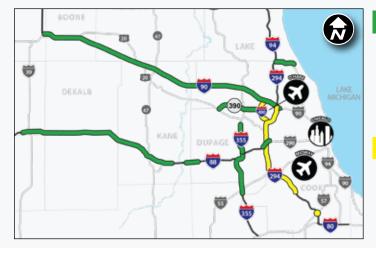

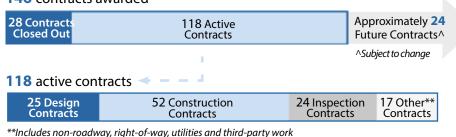

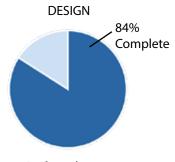

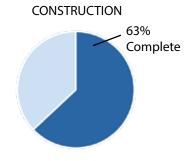

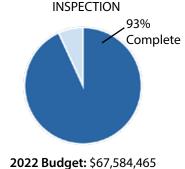

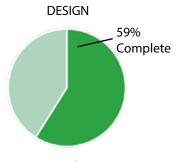

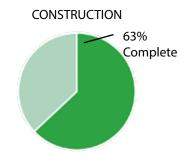

2022 PROJECT PROGRESS BY PHASE

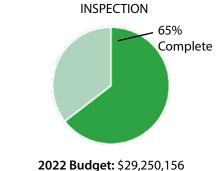

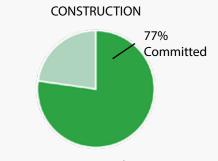

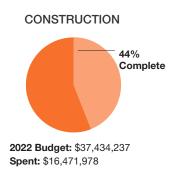

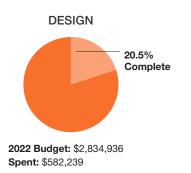


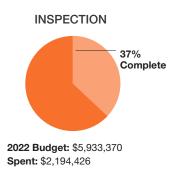




2022 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
