Board of Directors Meeting

Record of Meeting | January 26, 2023

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority's ("Tollway") Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, January 26, 2023, in the Boardroom of Tollway Headquarters in Downers Grove, Illinois. The meeting was held pursuant to the By-Laws of the Tollway upon call and notice of the meeting executed by Chair Dorothy Abreu and posted in accordance with the requirements of the Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/1, *et seq.* The meeting was open to the public.

Call to Order / Roll Call

Chair Abreu called the meeting to order at approximately 9:35 a.m. Chair Abreu stated that given Director McConnaughay's advance notice to the Board Secretary of her inability to attend in person due to conflicting business, and given that a quorum of the Board is physically present, in accordance with Illinois Open Meetings Act Section *7*(a), a motion is requested to approve Director McConnaughay's participation by audio conference. Director Gallagher made such a motion, seconded by Director Perinar. The motion was PASSED unanimously by voice vote. Director McConnaughay joined the Meeting via audio conference.

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Chair Abreu stated that the newly renovated east entrance and customer service center of Tollway Headquarters was re-opened to the pubic this week. Chair Abreu recognized the Board, the vendors and Tollway leadership for their contributions to the project.

Chair Abreu informed Directors that District 15 Captain Jason Bradley has been promoted to Major of the Chicago Region, effective January 1, and will oversee Illinois State Police patrols throughout nine counties in Northern Illinois, including Troop 15, the district dedicated to patrolling the Illinois Tollway system. Chair Abreu stated that Captain Linda Mandat, Captain Bradley's successor, is unable to attend today's meeting, and the Illinois State Police Safety Message will be provided this month by Lt. Malissa Feld.

Safety Message

Lt. Feld emphasized the importance of obeying Illinois' Scott's Law, which requires all drivers approaching any police or other emergency vehicle stopped along the roadway to proceed with caution, change lanes if possible, and reduce speed. She then reviewed the consequences of Scott's Law violations, which include a minimum \$250 fine for a first offense, escalating to fines of up to \$10,000 and potential suspension of driving privileges. Lt. Feld also recognized the losses of Troop 15 police officers and Tollway workers who were struck and injured or killed in performance of their duties. Chair Abreu thanked Lt. Feld and Troop 15 for their efforts.

Public Comment

Chair Abreu opened the floor for public comment. No comment was offered.

Chair's Items

Chair Abreu entertained a motion to approve **Chair's Item 1**, the Minutes of the Regular Board of Directors meeting held December 15, 2022, as presented. Director Gallagher made a motion to approve this item, seconded by Director Perinar. The motion was PASSED unanimously by voice vote.

<u>Item 2</u>: Approval of the Minutes of the Executive Session of the Regular Board of Directors Meeting held December 15, 2022.

Chair Abreu stated that without objection, action on Chair's Item 2 will be deferred until after consideration in the Executive Session.

Chair Abreu dispensed with committee reports, noting that all Directors were present for the committee meetings.

Item 6: Additional Items

Chair Abreu, having no further items, turned the floor over to Executive Director Cassaundra Rouse.

Executive Director's Items

Executive Director Rouse introduced a short video featuring highlights of the agency's accomplishments in 2022.

Upon completion of the video, Executive Director Rouse reported that the Tollway's I-294/I-57 Interchange Project was named "Project of the Year" in the Infrastructure category by the Construction Industry Service Corporation, which recognizes top-quality union construction projects throughout the region. Ms. Rouse stated that the project was selected for its positive impact on the community, safety record and the quality of its construction and design.

Executive Director Rouse recognized the Diversity & Strategic Development Department for its recent presentation at the Government Procurement Forum, where staff highlighted the benefits and success of the Tollway's Partnering for Growth program.

Ms. Rouse announced the promotions of longtime Tollway employees Angela Jenkins to Chief of Administration and Michael Catolico to Chief of Business Systems. Executive Director Rouse also congratulated five recently retired employees, each of whom had over 30 years of service at the Tollway, including Toll Audit Manager Fred Ross, Maintenance Section Manager Patrick Donolan, Executive Secretary in Roadway Maintenance Deborah Miller, Equipment Operator Laborer Todd Overlin and Painter Thomas Washick.

Finally, Executive Director Rouse introduced and welcomed Mike Bardou and Zachary Yack of the National Weather Service. She noted that the Tollway is being recognized by the National Weather Service as certified StormReady. Tollway Roadway Maintenance leadership including Darrion Robinson, Rohan Gayle and Joe Dragovich joined the meeting to receive the certification. Executive Director Rouse thanked the National Weather Service for the recognition and thanked the staff for keeping the Tollway System in good condition all year-round to ensure safe and efficient travel for Tollway customers.

Executive Director Rouse, having no further items to report, returned the floor to Chair Abreu.
