The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority ("Tollway") held the regularly scheduled Engineering, Planning & Development Oversight Committee meeting on Thursday, December 14, 2023, in the Boardroom of Tollway headquarters in Downers Grove, Illinois. The meeting was held pursuant to the By-Laws of the Tollway upon call and notice of the meeting executed by Chairman Arnaldo Rivera and posted in accordance with the requirements of the Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/1, et seq.

Committee Chair's Items

Committee Chair McConnaughay entertained a motion to approve **Committee Chair's Item 1**, the minutes of the regular Engineering, Planning & Development Oversight Committee meeting held on November 16, 2023, as presented. Executive Director

Executive Director Rouse introduced Chief Engineering Officer Manar Nashif to provide an update for the Board on the *Move Illinois* program. <u>See attached presentation</u>.

Director Sweeney acknowledged the challenges posed by the Elgin O'Hare Western Access project, particularly due to its proximity to O'Hare Airport and required coordination with the CP and UP railroads. He commended the staff for successfully keeping the project on schedule and within budget, despite the complexities inherent in the project and the extensive coordination required among partners.

Director Paddock suggested that the Tollway allocate resources to analyze the long-term economic impact of the *Move Illinois* program on the region.

Upon conclusion of the presentation and discussion, Committee Chair McConnaughay thanked Mr. Nashif.

Executive Director Rouse noted that the meeting agenda contains 9 items for the Committee's consideration.

<u>Item 4</u>: Award of Contract RR-23-4915 to Rock Road Companies, Inc. for Ramp Pavement Repairs on the Jane Addams Memorial Tollway (I-90) at Mile Post 25.0 (Genoa Road) in the amount of \$699,083.92.

<u>Item 8</u>: Award of Contract 23-0143 to Midwest Mobile Waterjet, LLC (d.b.a. AWT, LLC) for the purchase of Refurbishing Services for Aluminum Sign Blanks and Aluminum Extrusions in an amount not to exceed \$645,950.00 (Tollway Invitation for Bid).






