ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE RESULTS OF NIGHTTIME ENFORCEMENT PATROLS

Downers Grove, IL – Illinois State Police (ISP) Troop 15 Commander Linda Mandat announces the results of Nighttime Enforcement (NITE) patrols in Cook, DuPage and Lake counties during May. These NITE patrols allowed the ISP to focus on preventing, detecting and taking enforcement action in response to impaired driving and occupant restraint violations especially between the hours of 6:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.
