ILLINOIS STATE POLICE ANNOUNCE RESULTS OF OCCUPANT RESTRAINT ENFORCEMENT PATROLS

Downers Grove, IL – Illinois State Police (ISP) Troop 15 Acting Commander Ken Benson announces the results of Occupant Restraint Enforcement Patrols (OREP) held in Cook, DuPage and Lake counties during November. These OREPs provided extra patrol coverage for the ISP so officers could focus on saving lives by making sure all vehicle occupants were buckled up.
