MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH FEBRUARY 2023

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.

MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2023)

\$12.0 billion or 84.3% of the program budget committed

\$7.4 billion, or approximately 51.7%, in construction work

53.0 billion, or approximately 21.1%, in consultant services

\$1.7 billion, or approximately 12.0%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$210.3 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.5%

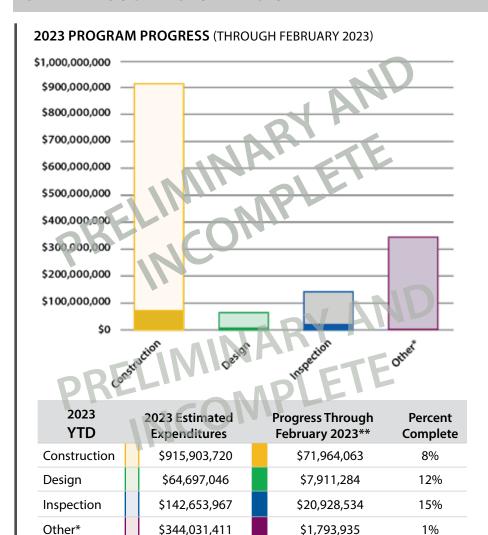

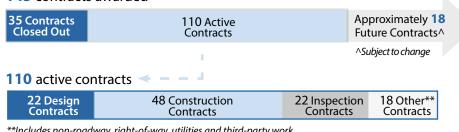

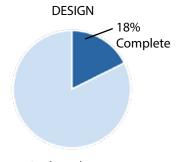

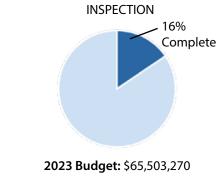

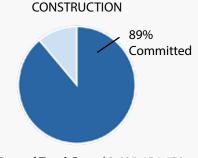

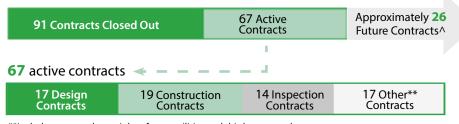

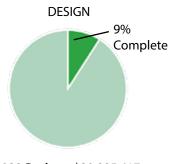

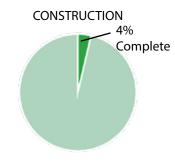

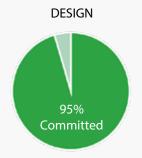

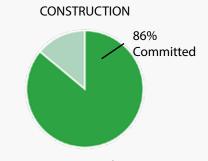

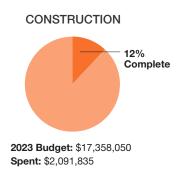

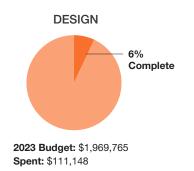


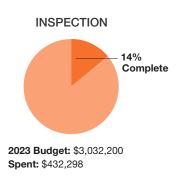




2023 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
