MOVE ILLINOIS CAPITAL PROGRAM

DATA THROUGH MAY 2023

In 2012, the Illinois Tollway launched the 15-year, \$12 billion capital program, *Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future*. In 2017, the Board of Directors expanded the program to \$14 billion.

MOVE ILLINOIS PROGRAM BUDGET OVERVIEW (2012-2023)

\$12.1 billion or **84.7**% of the program budget committed

57.4 billion, or approximately 52.0%, in construction work

53.0 billion, or approximately 21.0%, in consultant services

51.7 billion, or approximately 11.9%, in other costs (utilities, ROW, misc.)

\$210.3 million in reimbursement agreements has been approved; reducing overall program costs by 1.5%

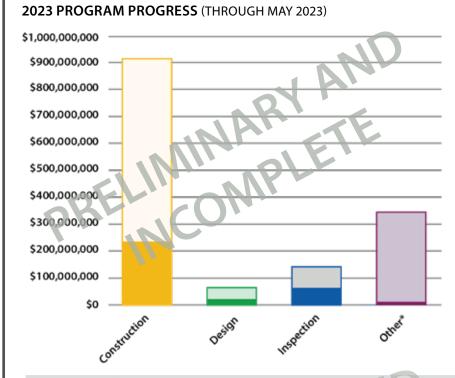

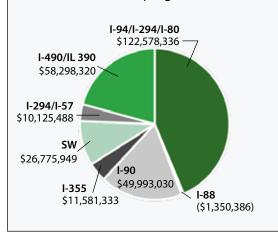

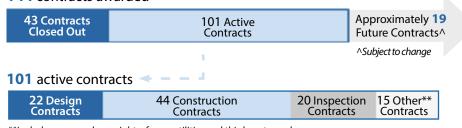

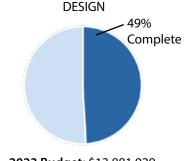

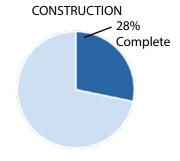

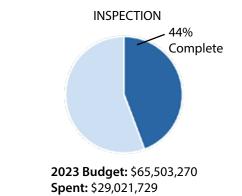

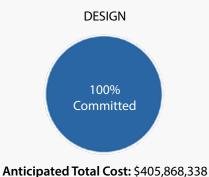

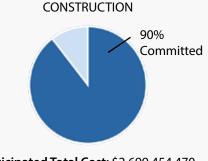

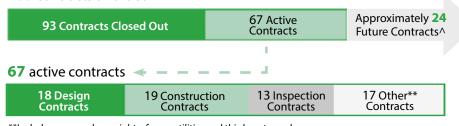

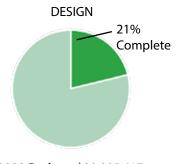

I-490 CORRIDOR STATUS DIAGRAM

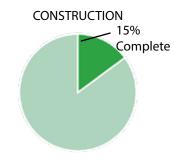

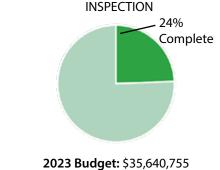

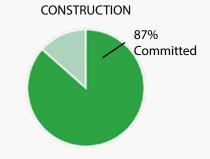

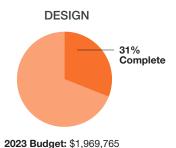




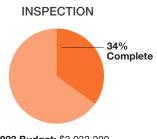
2023 MAINTENANCE FACILITY BUDGET
