**Finance Department** 

**Description:** The Tollway is required by 5 ILCS 375/11 of the State Employees Group Insurance Act to reimburse CMS for the cost of other post-employment (medical, dental and life insurance) benefits for Tollway retirees (excluding Illinois State Police Troop 15 retirees). This payment is required because the Tollway does not participate in the State Employee Group Insurance Plan (SEGIP) for its active employees and, therefore, does not pay the "retiree-load" portion of the monthly premium for active participants like other state agencies do. A portion of the monthly premiums paid by SEGIP participants represents a "retiree-load" determined by CMS. The Tollway sponsors its own benefit plans for active Tollway employees. Prior to 2022, the required payment was calculated based on Tollway pro-rata share of total state service credit multiplied by the retiree's medical, dental and life premiums.

Legislation enacted on 01/09/2023 amended the State Employees Group Insurance Act to require the Tollway to calculate its share of retiree premiums using the "retiree-load" methodology. The amendment requires the Tollway to remit the "retiree-load" amount for its active employees each month, rather than calculating actual pro-rata service credit of retirees. The Tollway no longer computes pro-rata service credit to determine its payment for retiree medical, dental and life benefits.

This Resolution will allow for the payment of the 2023 premium amount, determined using the amended "retiree-load" methodology.

Scope: Authorization to reimburse CMS for the Tollway's share of the state's cost of other post-employment benefits for retirees receiving benefits through the State of Illinois State Employees Group Insurance Program.
