In accordance with the Tollway's Board-approved process for approving change orders and extra work orders, which is set forth in Resolution Nos. 16832, 17250 and 19806, the Tollway recommends approval of an Extra Work Order increasing the upper limit of compensation on Contract No. I-21-4732 in an amount not to exceed \$1,090,717.05.

An Extra Work Order in the amount of \$1,090,717.05 and a commensurate increase in the upper limit of compensation on Contract No. I-21-4732, increasing the upper limit of compensation from \$228,948,561.79 to \$230,039,278.84, is approved. The Chair and Chief Executive Officer of the Tollway is authorized to execute the appropriate documents in connection therewith, subject to the approval of the General Counsel and the Chief Financial Officer, and the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to issue and deliver warrants in payment thereof.
