## ILLINOIS TOLLWAY LAUNCHES FIRST TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM LOCATION AT ROCK VALLEY COLLEGE IN ROCKFORD

**WHAT**: The Illinois Tollway is opening its first Technical Assistance Program location in the

Rockford area to help diverse, minority- and women-owned firms as well as small and

veteran-owned businesses learn to compete for Tollway construction contracts.

The Tollway's Technical Assistance Program services at Rock Valley College, offered in partnership with the Construction Business Development Center (CBDC) administered by Prairie State College, will help prepare firms to participate on highway and vertical

construction contracts.

**WHY:** The Tollway hopes to increase the pool of qualified, diverse firms competing for

contracts awarded for its 15-year, \$12 billion Move Illinois capital program, while also

stimulating economic development and creating new, good-paying jobs.

The Tollway is establishing three locations in the Rockford area with technical assistance partner agencies to offer comprehensive, customized business development assistance for firms to build financial understanding and business plan development for increased

business stability and growth in the transportation-related construction industry.
