





Air Quality

MOVE ILLINOIS

- Provide accommodation for Zero Emission vehicles.
- Utilization of renewable power sources for roadway lighting (i.e. solar and wind).
- Consider revisions to the Construction Air Quality – Diesel Vehicle Emission Controls to require EPA Tier 4 diesel construction equipment.



Aesthetics



- 13 interchanges
- 65 bridges carrying I-294 over different features
- 21 bridges over I-294
- 2 oases
- 5 mainline toll plazas
- 18+ miles of noisewalls






Aesthetics



- Consider creating a consistent corridor wide theme
- Incorporate wayfinding into interchange aesthetics (structure, landscaping, etc.)
- Balance aesthetics with function of roadway

Pedestrian & Bicycling Accommodations









- Improve connectivity to existing trails
- Coordinate with existing plans along corridor
- Focus on opportunities and partnerships to fund and implement improvements
