



# **Regular Board of Directors Meeting**

# Record of Meeting | February 25, 2016

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (the "Tollway") Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, February 25, 2016 in the Boardroom of Tollway Headquarters in Downers Grove, Illinois. The Meeting was held pursuant to By-Laws of the Tollway upon call and notice of the Meeting executed by Chairman Robert J. Schillerstrom and posted in accordance with the requirements of the Illinois *Open Meetings Act*. The Meeting was open to the public.

### Call to Order / Pledge of Allegiance / Roll Call

Chairman Bob Schillerstrom called the Meeting to order at approximately 9:00 a.m., stating that this is the regularly scheduled meeting of the Board of Directors of the Tollway. He invited attendees to rise and join in the Pledge of Allegiance. He then asked the Board Secretary to call the roll, those Directors present and absent being as follows:

The Board Secretary declared a quorum present.

#### **Public Comment**

Chairman Schillerstrom opened the floor for public comment.

Robert Baker, President of the Save our Community Coalition, addressed the Board. Mr. Baker expressed his gratitude to Gustavo Giraldo, Chief of Diversity and Strategic Development, and



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Greg Bedalov, Executive Director, for recently meeting with him. He stated he is encouraged that his regular public comments to the Board concerning participation of African Americans are being heard. He urged the Board to continue to advance initiatives to increase workforce diversity and suggested that labor unions be encouraged to play an active role in addressing diversity within the industry.

#### Chairman's Items

<u>Item 1</u>: Approval of the Minutes of the regular Board of Directors meeting held January 25, 2016.

Chairman Schillerstrom called for a motion to approve **Chairman's Item 1**, the Minutes of the regular Board of Directors meeting held on January 25, 2016, as presented. Director Banks made a motion for approval; seconded by Director Gomez. Chairman Schillerstrom asked if there are any questions, concerns or requests for amendment. Hearing nothing, Chairman Schillerstrom called for a vote. The motion PASSED by unanimous vote of those Directors present; Director Gonzalez having not yet entered.

Chairman Schillerstrom stated that action on Chairman's Item 2, the Minutes of the Executive Session of the Board of Directors meeting held on January 25, 2016, will be deferred until after consideration in Executive Session.

#### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Chairman Schillerstrom asked the chairs of the following committees of the Board if they had any report to provide on the committees' recent activities:

### **Finance, Administration & Operations Committee**

Committee Chair Gomez updated the Board on the Finance, Administration and Operations Committee ("FAO Committee") meeting held Thursday, February 18, 2016, providing the following highlights:

**FINANCE** presented two items which were approved by the Committee for placement on the Board agenda with a recommendation for approval:

- An award of contract to Vantiv, LLC., to continue merchant card processing for I-PASS transactions, violation payments, and other payments to the Tollway through May 2018;
- Authorization to issue \$300 million of fixed-rate bonds to finance *Move Illinois* projects, and approval of underwriter assignments for each of the next two bond transactions.



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**PROCUREMENT** presented seven items which were approved by the Committee for placement on the Board agenda with a recommendation for approval:

- A request to utilize Department of Central Management Services master contracts to purchase 12 police pursuit vehicles for Illinois State Police District 15.
- Six Tollway invitations for bid to purchase off-road equipment; tripwire software and related items; luminaires and components; equipment trailers; walk-behind concrete saws; and wood sign posts.

**ENGINEERING** presented 16 items which were reviewed and approved by the Committee for placement on the Board agenda with a recommendation for approval:

- Ten construction contracts, four of which are small business set-asides with three firms serving as prime contractor for the first time;
- One professional services contract for work on the Elgin O'Hare Western Access corridor and one professional services contract supplement for additional construction management services at the Pine Dunes Wetland Mitigation facility; and
- Four construction contract extra work orders/change orders.

An additional small business set-aside contract, which was not ready for presentation at Committee due to timing of the bid opening, will be presented to the full Board for consideration today.

The final Engineering item, deferred at Committee, is related to land acquisition and will be reviewed in Executive Session prior to full Board consideration.

**LEGAL** presented four intergovernmental agreements ("IGAs") which were approved by the Committee for placement on the Board agenda with a recommendation for approval:

- An IGA with the Village of Schaumburg and Cook County;
- A Second Addendum to an IGA with the Illinois Community College Board to utilize resources for increasing the capacity of small construction firms;
- A First Addendum to an IGA with the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity for technical assistance to small businesses;
- An IGA with the Illinois Department of Transportation ("IDOT") pertaining to the transfer of parcels between the Tollway and IDOT.

An additional item, which authorizes the assignment of bond counsel for the Tollway's next bond transaction, will be presented to the full Board for consideration today.





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Finally, two land administrative settlement items and a workers' compensation settlement, each deferred at Committee, will be reviewed in Executive Session prior to consideration by the full Board.

### **Diversity & Inclusion Committee**

In the absence of Committee Chair Brooks, Executive Director Bedalov updated the Board on the Diversity & Inclusion Committee meeting held Thursday, February 18, 2016, providing the following highlights:

Staff provided an overview of the Career Opportunities Expo being held February 26<sup>th</sup> at the New Beginnings Church of Chicago. The Expo will help connect prospective workers with public- and private-sector employers and jobs as part of the Tollway's ongoing focus on diversity issues and initiatives. Registration has reached capacity, having in excess of 1,000 attendees registered. Attendees will have the opportunity to meet one-on-one with more than 50 businesses, state agencies, construction trades and organizations that will provide information about employment readiness and job opportunities. The event will also include breakout sessions that highlight information on construction career opportunities and training programs, as well as training in resume building and interviewing skills.

Staff also provided an overview of the Diversity Advisory Council ("DAC") meeting held on February 3<sup>rd</sup> at which the timeline for the subcommittees to finalize their recommendations was discussed. These recommendations, along with the recommendations of the Disparity Study, will serve as resources for preparation of the Committee's final report, anticipated to be presented to the Board in May. Notable ideas emanating from the DAC meeting included rebranding the mentor/protégé program being developed for construction and to include Illinois Road Builders in its development. Other ideas included continuing the unbundling of contracts, focusing on increasing opportunities for veterans, and establishing a technical assistance program for goods and services firms.

An update on the Tollway's Small Business Program was also provided by staff. The program would allow the Tollway to set goals for registered small businesses on construction contracts. The agency is currently finalizing the small business special provision to be inserted into all contracts containing a small business goal, and working with the State Procurement Office to ensure that the program adheres to state procurement rules. The first projects with a small business goal are anticipated to be selected later this year.

Finally, the Tollway announced that the technical assistance programs with the Illinois Black Chamber of Commerce and the Hispanic American Construction Industry Association will be



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fully operational by the end of the first quarter. The Tollway will also be extending the agreements to continue operating the Construction Business Development Center (CBDC) and the Construction Coaching for Growth (CC4G) programs through the end of December. Those agreements were set to expire in March. Meanwhile, the Tollway will be advertising a new request for proposal ("RFP") for construction technical assistance programs by the end of March. Additionally, the Tollway is preparing an RFP in the first quarter of 2016 for new diversity management software.

Having no further items, Chairman Schillerstrom called on Executive Director Greg Bedalov.

#### **Executive Director**

**Outreach:** Executive Director Bedalov reported on his recent attendance at the Hispanic American Construction Industry Association's 37th Annual Awards Banquet and his planned attendance at HNTB's national THINK: Infrastructure forum. He emphasized it is a priority for the agency to accept invitations like this in order to promote the Tollway and its commitments to technology, jobs, environmental sustainability and economic development while delivering its capital programs on schedule and within budget.

**Employment Plans**: Executive Director Bedalov reported that the agency has recently filed its annual Employment Plans with the Illinois General Assembly, outlining goals and objectives for diversifying the Tollway's workforce through recruitment, hiring, promotion, and retention of African-Americans, Latinos and Asian-Americans at supervisory, technical, professional and managerial levels. He noted the agency also voluntarily submitted an African American Employment Plan to demonstrate the importance placed by the Tollway on hiring a workforce that reflects the diversity of Illinois.

Got it. Do it. Done: Executive Director Bedalov reported that the Tollway's "Got it. Do it. Done." campaign launched in December focusing on updating I-PASS accounts. He explained that the agency is alerting drivers that replacement "smart credit cards" being issued by financial institutions may have new account numbers or new expiration dates that must be updated to keep their I-PASS accounts in good standing. He highlighted that the innovative techniques used by the Tollway's Communications team have successfully generated a 60 percent increase in credit card updates, as compared to last year.

He advised that staff will prepare a more detailed cost-benefit analysis and provide for Directors post-meeting.

# **Engineering**

<u>Item 1</u>: Award of Contract RR-15-9185 to CCC Holdings, Inc. dba Chicago Commercial Construction for North Parking Lot Improvements at the Tollway Central Administration Building in the amount of \$940,741.40.

Chairman Schillerstrom called for a motion to approve **Engineering Item 1**. Director Banks made a motion for approval; seconded by Director Johnson.

Chairman Schillerstrom asked Mr. Kovacs to present to the Board and to clarify the reason for advancing this item which was not previously reviewed at committee, as is customary.

During presentation of the item, Mr. Kovacs noted that although the bid opening for the contract occurred subsequently to the public notice deadline for the FAO Committee meeting, the Engineering Department felt that there would be benefit to advancing the contract, a small business set-aside, so that work can commence as soon as possible. He advised that the Engineering Department also felt that commencing work in a timely manner would demonstrate the agency's responsiveness to the public, who have made complaints concerning the availability of parking at Tollway Headquarters.

Chairman Schillerstrom inquired of the Board whether there is any objection to proceeding with consideration of this item. Hearing nothing, he indicated the item will proceed; however, he encouraged staff to adhere, as a general practice, to the process by which items are vetted first at committee prior to their consideration by the Board. Chairman Schillerstrom then asked if there are any questions, concerns or requests for discussion of this item.

Director Sauer asked how many spaces are proposed as additions to the parking lot. Mr. Kovacs responded 52.

Director Sweeney inquired about the self-performance requirement on the contract. Mr. Kovacs replied that he believes the contractor has a self-performance requirement of greater than 35%, which is typical for Tollway contracts; however, **he will confirm and follow-up with Directors post-meeting**.



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Hearing nothing further, Chairman Schillerstrom called for a roll call on the pending motion, the vote of yeas and nays being as follows:

With permission of the Chairman, Mr. Kovacs then provided for the Board an overview of the Engineering items on the Meeting agenda, highlights from which include:

- Six of the construction contracts on the agenda represent approximately \$51 million in overall improvements, 25% of which has been committed to disadvantaged business enterprise ("DBE") or veteran-owned firms, exceeding the 20% goal established.
- Five of the construction contracts on the agenda have been identified under the Tollway's Small Business Set-Aside Program and these contracts received 27 bids in total.
- One construction contract on the Meeting agenda received 12 bids, a record number for the *Move Illinois* Capital Program.
- Since the start of *Move Illinois* in 2012, nearly 96 percent of the over 200 Tollway construction contracts awarded have met or are meeting or exceeding established DBE goals, with a total of only nine waivers having been requested.
- Pending approval of the current agenda items, since the inception of the Small Business Set-Aside Program in 2013, there will have been 26 small business contract awards resulting in 17 new firms to the Tollway.

Mr. Kovacs suggested these numbers indicate that overall interest in the Tollway's contracts remains strong, and reflect positively on the Tollway's ongoing efforts to create more opportunities for small and minority-, veteran- and women-owned businesses to participate.

Director Gomez asked whether Mr. Kovacs feels the increasing bid competition is a result of initiatives implemented within the past year. Mr. Kovacs responded that interest by the contracting community in Tollway contracts has remained strong the past twelve months, and may have increased over the prior year.

Directors Johnson and Sweeney inquired about the positive variances to budget recognized todate in the *Move Illinois* Capital Program, and the potential for positive impact of the current strength being experienced in bid competition. Mr. Kovacs cautioned that a long view must be taken when considering a 15 year program, advising that early program savings can potentially



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# years as a result of escalating costs. He advised that the Engine

be offset in subsequent years as a result of escalating costs. He advised that the Engineering Department is tracking the cost performance of *Move Illinois* contracts and an evaluation is expected to be performed in the coming months, which will be shared with Directors.
