Recommendations

- Makes clear that trade-offs of environmental impacts and costs are to be evaluated if expansion is considered
- Highlights the importance of improving the congestion concerns at the interchanges with I-290 and I-55
- Suggests transit improvements similar to those on I-90 be evaluated
