MINUTES OF THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE ILLINOIS STATE TOLL HIGHWAY AUTHORITY

September 27, 2007

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority met in regular session on Thursday, September 27, 2007 at approximately 10:00 a.m. in the Board Room of The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority's Administration Building in Downers Grove, Illinois.

Chairman Mitola called for a motion to allow Director Moore to participate by phone and to ratify her actions at the Finance and Administration Committee Meeting. She was prevented from physically attending because of personal illness, one of the approved reasons for such participation pursuant to Section 7 of the Open Meetings Act.

Director Pradel moved for approval; seconded by Director Towns.

Chairman Mitola called for a voice vote, and there being "Ayes" and no "Nays", declared the motion carried.

Chairman Mitola then called for public comment. There being none, he called for a motion approving the Minutes of the Special Board Meeting held on September 7, 2007. Director Andalcio moved for adoption of the Minutes; seconded by Director Banks.

Chairman Mitola called for a voice vote, and there being "Ayes" and no "Nays", declared the motion carried.

Chairman Mitola then welcomed Director Canham to the Board and thanked Director Materick for his service to the state and the Tollway.

Chairman Mitola then called on the Executive Director. Mr. Brian McPartlin also welcomed Director Canham and thanked Director Materick. He then briefed the Board on the following: The 2007 Illinois Green Government Annual Report was issued this month and the Tollway and our accomplishments are highlighted throughout the report. The Tollway was recognized for Fleet, Bikeways, Recycling, Coordination/CMAQ grant with Pace, Green Building practices, as well as the use of Ground Rubber Tires and Recycled Asphalt Pavement. There were also mentions of our habitat and wetland restoration work. The Tollway was also selected for a Sustainable Construction Practice Award.

The Tollway was also recently honored by ConstrucTech magazine with a 2007 Vision Award in the category of Public Administration/ Government.

Mr. McPartlin then discussed the plans to celebrate and dedicate the new I-355 South Extension on Sunday, November 11 and showed a video which was put together to get the message out about the new road and the planned celebration.

Chairman Mitola then called on the Chief of Finance. Mr. Mike Colsch requested adoption of a Resolution approving the amounts to be deposited into the Workers' Compensation Claim Reserve Fund. This appears in the Appendage as Resolution No. 17883.
