

Interchange/Roadway Cost Sharing Policy

- Initial Policy Enacted 2001 and Updated 2007
- 5 Primary Elements
 - Define Need for Project
 - Economic Development Analysis
 - 3. Traffic Analysis/Technical Evaluation
 - 4. Financial Plan
 - Resolutions of Support
- Cost Sharing Terms
 - 1. Tollway Maximum Contribution of 50%
 - 10-Year Cost Recovery

Project Cost and Projected Revenues

Project Cost Estimate

Construction: \$22,725,000

Right-of-Way: \$0

Toll Equipment: \$200,000

Construction Engineering: \$2,272,500

Total Project Cost: \$25,197,500

WSA Projected Revenue

- Included Diversions from Existing Toll Plazas (O'Hare East and River Road)
- ☐ Gross Projected Annual Revenue (2012): \$1.3M
- Net Projected Annual Revenue (2012): \$0.8M
- Additional Annual Operations and Maintenance Cost
 - **\$46,200**



Draft Intergovernmental Agreement Summary

- Village of Rosemont will finance project
- Rosemont is lead construction agency
- M/W/DBE requirements
- Tollway contribution will not exceed 50%
- Financing terms yet to be established
