Workers' Compensation Process

- Injury report filed
- Third-party administrator/claims adjuster assignment
 - Adjuster contacts employee, supervisors and witnesses
- Employee sends medical records to claims adjuster to approve, reconcile and pay medical provider
- Prescription card or code issued to cover immediate prescription needs
- Nurse case manager assigned



Workers' Compensation Process

Treatment and recovery process

- Regular duty
- Transitional duty in department
 - Employee's department in most cases
- Off duty vocational rehabilitation



Calculating Claim Costs Costs of Claim Example

- Temporary Total Disability (TTD) \$19,200
 - \$600 2/3 of AWW (average weekly wage) x 32 weeks (off work)
- Permanent Partial Disability (PPD) \$44,275
 - \$500 PPD x 35 percent loss of arm x 253 weeks
- Medical \$150,000
- Legal \$7,500
- Expenses \$10,000
- Total Cost of Claim: \$230,975



Methods to Limit Costs

- Report accidents immediately
- Investigate accident site
- Obtain witness statements
- Immediate access to treatment
- Increase nurse case management
- Workplace videos for medical providers
- Safe summer program
